

A letter from our Pastor

We are just at the beginning of our Lenten journey and one thing that might be good to consider is the first verse of Matthew 4 *Then Jesus was led up by the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted by the devil.* Our Lord was led by the Spirit. In this continual time of the archdiocesan campaign of Renew My Church we are in the second phase of Spiritual Renewal. The main aspect of this is that like Jesus we be led by the Spirit. One of the ways we will be doing this during this Lenten season is offer a prayer for the Spirit to renew us both as individuals and as a parish. Our Holy Father, who we offer our continued prayers, mentions in his Lenten letter that we are called to journey together in hope. The greatest way we can do this is in the Spirit.

Lent calls us to open ourselves to the transformative power of the Holy Spirit, who changes lives. Lent is an opportunity for all of us to experience the power of the Holy Spirit at work as we encounter God's love for us. We encounter God's love in many ways. We remember that we encounter God's love in our going to Mass and being open to the experience. We encounter God's love in the embrace of a community or the kind word of the person sitting in the pew behind us. We encounter God's love in the invitation of a friend to experience the sacraments in ways that prompt us to serve our neighbors as we put faith into action in our lives.

This Season we are invited to ask important questions. The Holy Father reminds us to ask: *Am I really on a journey, or am I standing still, not moving, either immobilized by fear and hopelessness or reluctant to move out of my comfort zone? Am I seeking ways to leave behind the occasions of sin and situations that degrade my dignity? It would be a good Lenten exercise for us to compare our daily life with that of some. The Holy Spirit impels us not to remain self-absorbed, but to leave ourselves behind and keep walking towards God and our brothers and sisters.*^[3] *Journeying together means consolidating the unity grounded in our common dignity as children of God (cf. Gal 3:26-28). It means walking side-by-side, without shoving or stepping on others, without envy or hypocrisy, without letting anyone be left behind or excluded. Let us all walk in the same direction, tending towards the same goal, attentive to one another in love and patience.*

Pope Francis reminds us that the Spirit calls us to renewal to conversion so that we might embrace God's great promise of eternal life. *Let us ask ourselves: Am I convinced that the Lord forgives my sins? Or do I act as if I can save myself? Do I long for salvation and call upon God's help to attain it? Do I concretely experience the hope that enables me to interpret the events of history and inspires in me a commitment to justice and fraternity, to care for our common home and in such a way that no one feels excluded?*

Let us ask the Spirit to renew us during this Lenten season knowing that Spirit is doing the mighty work in our lives Let us echo the Holy Father's prayer: May the Virgin Mary, Mother of Hope, intercede for us and accompany us on our Lenten journey.

Operations Update

Here is a quick update of some things that are going on in parish operations:

- A sprinkler pipe in the Religious Education wing of our campus froze and caused extensive water damage. As of February 27th, the remediation of the wing has been completed with no signs of water or mold. Preventative measures have been taken to ensure that no mold forms.
- The sprinklers should be repaired by the time you read this. No occupancy will be allowed until the sprinklers are working.
- The Religious Education team has been working feverishly to ensure that the disruption to the program is as minimal as possible. Please keep reading the various emails that are sent to the RE families.
- Hopefully, the plans for restoration will be finalized by the time you read this article.

Second Collections

In October of 2021, our parish began to have a monthly second collection for Capital Improvement, to raise funds to pay for the various capital needs of the parish. This has been a tremendous success in that it allowed us to pay for several large ticket capital improvements, such as replacing our church roof (\$150,000), repairing our parking lot (\$39,000), and the painting of our church (nearly \$40,000) to name a few.

Since January 2024, we began to have actual second collections that the Archdiocese has asked of parishes, to support various interests and organizations which the Archdiocese sponsors, such as the Church in Latin America and the Church in Eastern Europe. Previously, we did not "pass the basket" a second time and counted on parishioners to place the envelopes they received in the basket with the regular Sunday collections.

It has been decided to return to that previous model. We will continue to have our monthly second collections for Capital Improvements. However, we ask that, when you receive an envelope for the other collections, to please just deposit it with the Sunday envelopes.
