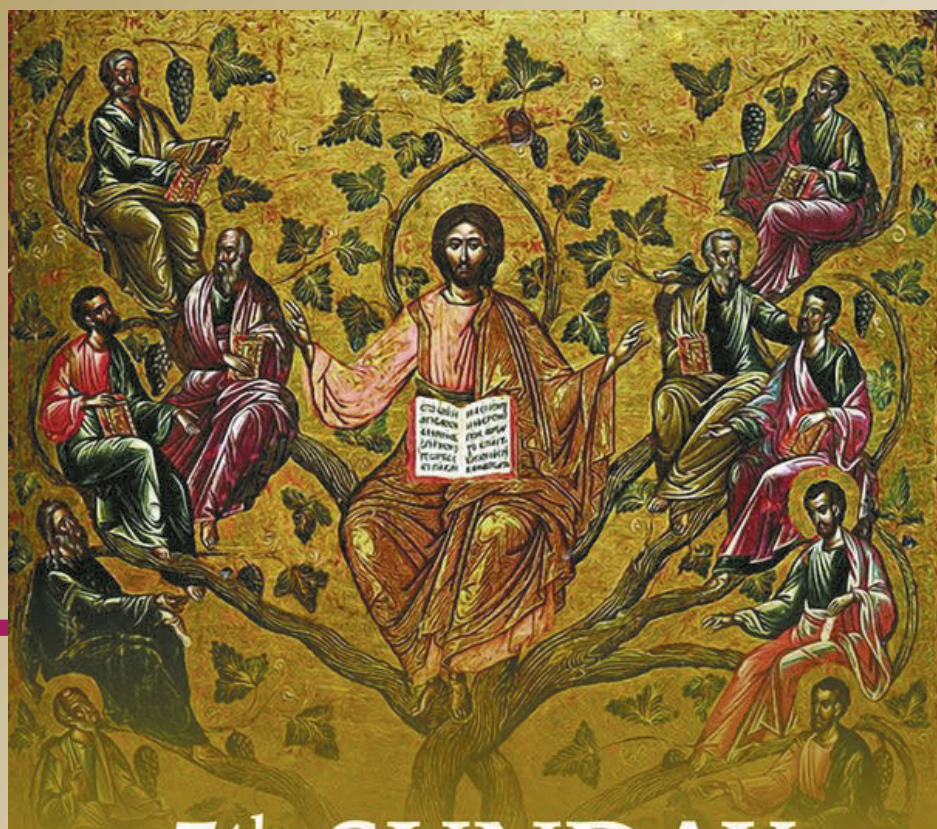

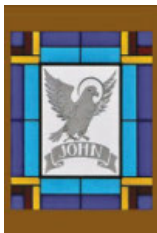

Dear Parishioners,

I want to offer a heartfelt word of congratulations to all the boys and girls who received their First Holy Communion here at Saint John's last Saturday. What a special day it was not only for each of them, but also for their families and the entire parish community!! I pray that God will continue to bless and watch over these children and help them understand the importance of the Eucharist in their lives. May they continue to celebrate this communion with Jesus and their love for Him with their families each Sunday at Mass.

I would like to offer a special word of thanks to all who helped prepare these children for this special day, especially Mrs. Mary Thon and all our teachers, catechists, and aides. They have given a great deal of their time and energy to make this day possible and I am very grateful to them for sharing their faith with our children. May God reward them for their ministry to our parish.



I am happy to let you know that St. John's now has relics of Blessed Michał Tomaszek and Zbigniew Strzałkowski, two young Conventual Franciscan Missionary Friars from Poland. Since 1989 they lived in the Peruvian Andes, bringing the Gospel of Jesus Christ to the people of Pariacoto, in the Diocese of Chimbote. They chose to work among the poor farm workers distributing food and medicine to help the immediate needs of the people. Their youthful enthusiasm was appreciated by the people who responded by helping to build and strengthen a robust faith community. Fr. Michał was loved especially by the children. Fr. Zbigniew visited, comforted, and encouraged the elderly, sick, and troubled.

On August 9, 1991, a group of about twenty guerillas of the revolutionary "Senderoso Luminoso" (Shining Path) broke into their friary, kidnapped them, and murdered them because of their defense of the Gospel values and work with the poor. The guerrillas motivated the killing of the two friars with these words: "they deceive the people because they distribute food of Caritas, which is imperialism; with the recitation of the rosary, the worship of Saints, Mass and the reading of the Bible they preach peace and they therefore make people fall asleep".

Pope Francis gave approval on February 3, 2015 to their beatification after affirming their martyrdom, and the celebration of beatification was celebrated in Peru on December 5, 2015.

The lives and deaths of Blessed Fr. Michał and Fr. Zbigniew show us that it is only by walking in the footsteps of Jesus Christ, sharing the poverty of the poor, teaching and living the Beatitudes, and leading one another to God, that we can conquer the darkness of our world.

Their relics you can find in our Marian Chaple right next to the relic of St. Peregrine.

Informacje parafialne



Juz za kilka dni rozpoczniemy miesiąc maj. Maj, to dla wielu najpiękniejszy miesiąc roku, a w Kościele to czas szczególnej czci Matki Bożej. W Polsce żywa jest tradycja gromadzenia się wieczorami w kościołach, przy grotach, kapliczkach i figurach przydrożnych na nabożeństwach nazywanych "*majówkami*". Zwyczaj ten trwa od połowy XIX wieku. Rodowód tych nabożeństw jest jednak znacznie wcześniejszy. Gromadzenie się i śpiewanie pieśni na cześć Matki Bożej było znane na Wschodzie już w V wieku. W Kościele zachodnim dopiero na przełomie XIII i XIV w. powstała myśl, aby miesiąc maj poświęcić Maryi. Pierwszym, który zainicjował tę myśl, był król hiszpański Alfons X (+1284). Władca ten zapraszał do udziału w nabożeństwach majowych, sam często brał w nich udział i swoim poddanym zalecał gromadzenie się w porze wieczornej na modlitwy wokół figur Matki Bożej. Dominikanin bł. Henryk Suzo wyznaje, że jako dziecko zbierał w maju kwiaty i niósł je do stóp Matki Bożej. Lubił z kwiatów pleść wieńce i kłaść je na głowę figur Bożej Rodzicielki. W żywocie św. Filipa Nereusza czytamy, że gromadził on dzieci przy figurach i obrazach Matki Bożej, śpiewał z nimi pieśni, zbierał kwiaty i zachęcał do składania ku Jej czci oprócz kwiatów, także duchowych ofiar i wyrzeczeń. Jednakże za autora właściwych nabożeństw majowych historycznie uważa się jezuitę, ojca Ansolani. On to w kaplicy królewskiej w Neapolu codziennie w maju urządzał koncert pieśni ku czci Bożej Matki, który kończył się błogosławieństwem Najświętszym Sakramentem.

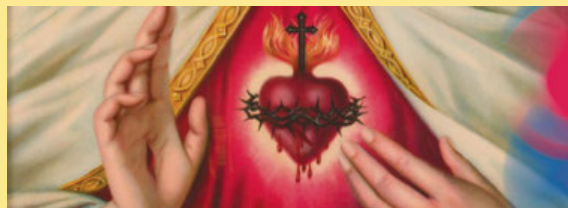
Centralną częścią nabożeństwa majowego jest *Litania Loretańska*, jest jednym z najwspanialszych hymnów na cześć Maryi, w którym wysławiane są Jej wielkie cnoty i przywileje, jakimi obdarzył Ją Bóg. Nie ma pewności, kiedy powstała Litania Loretańska. Pewne jest to, że zatwierdził ją oficjalnie papież Sykstus V w 1578 r. Nazwę "Loretańska" otrzymała od miejscowości Loretto we Włoszech, gdzie była szczególnie propagowana i odmawiana prawdopodobnie od 1531 r. W litanii wymieniane są kolejne tytuły Maryi i jest ich w sumie 52. Po zatwierdzeniu liturgicznej uroczystości NMP Królowej Polski, obchodzonej 3 maja, do Litanii dołączono 12 października 1923 r. wezwanie "*Królowo Polskiej Korony*", przekształcone po drugiej wojnie światowej na "*Królowo Polski*".

Matka Boża nigdy nie pozostaje głucha na wołanie i płacz swoich dzieci. Zawsze cierpliwie ich wysłuchuje, by przez swoje wstawiennictwo i orędownictwo wyjednać u Chrystusa potrzebne im łaski. Przez uczestnictwo w majowym nabożeństwie, jego scenerii i prostocie, można znaleźć odpowiedź na bardzo wiele wątpliwości, odnaleźć i odbudować korzenie swojej wiary. Nabożeństwo majowe to spotkanie z Matką Boga i z Nim samym, to możliwość zawierzenia Jej całej swojej życiowej codzienności. Trzeba tylko pójść do Niej, opowiedzieć Jej o tym i zaufać Jej w każdej sprawie. Na pewno zawsze przytuli do swojego Serca, pośpieszy z pomocą, wyprowadzi na właściwą drogę.

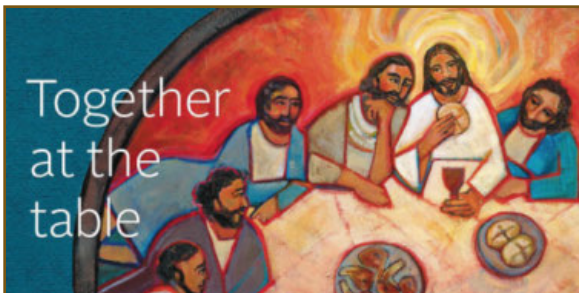
