

Informacje parafialne

Czerwiec to miesiąc szczególnego kultu Najświętszego Serca Chrystusowego i Tajemnicy Eucharystii. W tradycji Kościoła za początek kultu Serca Bożego uważa się moment przebicia Serca Pana Jezusa na krzyżu.

Nabożeństwo czerwcowe ma swoją bogatą historię. Osobą która zaproponowała, aby miesiąc czerwiec był poświęcony czci Serca Jezusowego była wychowanka jednego z paryskich klasztorów. Nazywała się ona Aniela de Sainte-Croix. Pewnego dnia dziewczynka ta, po przyjęciu Komunii świętej, pomyślała sobie, że skoro miesiąc maj poświęcony jest Matce Bożej, to dobrze będzie, gdy miesiąc czerwiec zostanie ofiarowany Sercu Jezusowemu. Podzieliła się swym pomysłem z wychowawczynią i swymi koleżankami, którym pomysł ten bardzo się spodobał. Przychylnie byli nastawieni do niego również przełożona klasztoru oraz biskup paryski.

Wybór terminu nie był przypadkowy. Wiele lat wcześniej miały, bowiem miejsce ważne objawienia, które są źródłem dla kultu Serca Jezusowego. Szesnastego czerwca 1675 roku, kiedy siostra wizytka św. Małgorzata Maria Alacoque modliła się w kaplicy klasztoru w Paray-le-Monial (Francja), już po raz trzeci objawił się jej Pan Jezus. Powiedział wtedy do niej: "Żądam, żeby pierwszy piątek po oktawie Bożego Ciała



był odtąd poświęcony jako osobne święto na uczczenie mojego Serca i na wynagrodzenie mi przez Komunię świętą i inne praktyki pobożne za zniewagi, jakich doznaję, gdy w czasie oktawy jestem wystawiony na ołtarzach. W zamian za to obiecuję ci, że Serce moje wyleje hojne łaski na tych wszystkich, którzy w ten sposób Sercu memu oddadzą cześć lub przyczynią się do jej rozszerzenia." Zasadniczymi elementami nabożeństwa czerwcowego są adoracja Najświętszego Sakramentu oraz Litania do Najświętszego Serca Jezusowego. Autorką Litanii była siostra Joanna Magdalena Joly. Litania przez nią napisana odmawiana była powszechnie w czasie wielkiej zarazy, jaka panowała w Marsylli w roku 1720. Następnie inna siostra - Anna Remusat wzbogaciła tę litanię o kilka nowych wezwań. W 1899 r. Kongregacja Obrzędów zatwierdziła litanię do publicznego odmawiania. Do istniejących 27 wezwań dodano 6 dalszych. W ten sposób Litania licząca 33 wezwania upamiętnia każdy rok życia Chrystusa na ziemi.

Papież Pius IX w roku 1873 zatwierdził nabożeństwo czerwcowe jako oficjalną modlitwę Kościoła. Warto pamiętać również i o tym, że papież Leon XIII poświęcił cały rodzaj ludzki Najświętszemu Sercu Jezusa 11 czerwca 1899 roku a sto lat później, nasz Rodak Ojciec Święty Jan Paweł II, akt ten ponowił podczas nabożeństwa czerwcowego, sprawowanego dnia 7 czerwca 1999 r. w Toruniu. W czerwcu także przypada Święto Najświętszego Serca Pana Jezusa – 24 czerwca.





















