



Informacje parafialne



"Każda rodzina cieszy się z narodzin dziecka, które jest owocem miłości rodziców i darem Boga. Z każdym dzieckiem są związane plany i marzenia, że wyrośnie na wspaniałego człowieka i będzie dumą rodziny. Jan Chrzciciel nie przychodzi na świat, aby zrealizować rodzinne ambicje. On przychodzi, aby przygotować ludzkie serca na przyjęcie Mesjasza i zaświadczyć, że Jezus z Nazaretu jest Zbawicielem świata."

Jakub Kruczek OP, "Oremus" czerwiec 2008, s. 100-101

Jak co roku, 24 czerwca, Kościół będzie obchodził uroczystość Narodzenia św. Jana Chrzciciela. Jest to wyjątkowy święty – jako jedyny cieszy się przywilejem obchodzenia uroczystości w dniu swoich ziemskich urodzin. Dodatkowo św. Jan wspominany jest w kalendarzu liturgicznym 29 sierpnia, kiedy to obchodzimy dzień jego męczeńskiej śmierci.

Jan Chrzciciel urodził się pół roku przed narodzinami Pana Jezusa w Judei, w mieście Aim Karim leżącym ok. 7 km od Jerozolimy. Był synem żydowskiego kapłana Zachariasza i Elżbiety, która była krewną Maryi. Jego narodzenie i szczególne posłannictwo zwiastował Zachariaszowi archanioł Gabriel.

Już w łonie Matki Jan Chrzciciel zwiastował nadejście zbliżającego się Zbawiciela. "W tym czasie Maryja wybrała się i poszła z pośpiechem w góry do pewnego miasta w pokoleniu Judy. Weszła do domu Zachariasza i pozdrowiła Elżbietę. Gdy Elżbieta usłyszała pozdrowienie Maryi, poruszyło się dzieciątko w jej łonie, a Duch Święty napełnił Elżbietę" (Łk 1,39-41).

Prawdopodobnie po śmierci rodziców św. Jan rozpoczął ascetyczne życie na Pustyni Judzkiej. Kiedy skończył 30 lat mógł według prawa występować publicznie i nauczać, co czynił w okolicach rzeki Jordan. Głównym celem jego misji stało się wzywanie ludzi do nawrócenia oraz przygotowanie drogi do publicznej służby Jezusa. Symbolem tego był chrzest udzielany przez proroka w rzece Jordan.

Wkrótce działalność św. Jana została zauważona przez starszyznę ludu oraz samego Heroda II Antypasa. Niedługo po chrzcie Jezusa twarde słowa Jana na temat niemoralnego małżeństwa tetrarchy Galilei stały się pretekstem, by wtrącić go do więzienia. W dniu urodzin Heroda, podczas uczty, na skutek spisku jego żony Herodiady, Jan został ścięty mieczem około 32 roku.

Sw. Jan Chrzciciel był pierwszym świętym czczonym w całym Kościele. W ikonografii św. Jan ukazywany jest jako dziecko, młodzieniec lub pustelnik, ubrany w skórę zwierzęcą albo płaszcz z sierści wielbłąda. Jego atrybutami są: baranek na ramieniu, na księdze lub u stóp, baranek z kielichem, chłopiec bawiący się z barankiem, głowa na misie i krzyż. W tradycji wschodniej, szczególnie na ikonach, święty przedstawiany jest jako zwiastun ze skrzydłami.

We are so grateful to all of you who helped us make this project a reality.


