

Informacje parafialne



W czasie wakacyjnym pamiętajmy o lekturze i rozważaniu słowa Bożego osobiście i w naszych rodzinach. Siegnijmy po być może zakurzona Biblie, odczytajmy słowa, które kieruje do nas sam Bóg. Warto pomyśleć o pogłębieniu naszej znajomości Pisma Świętego, bo jak mawiał św. Hieronim nieznajomość Pisma świętego jest nieznajomością Chrystusa. Pan Jezus po swoim zmartwychwstaniu oświecił umysły swoich uczniów, a więc i nasze, abyśmy rozumieli Pisma. Nie zmarnujmy tego daru. Ktokolwiek otworzy Biblie, powinien najpierw usilnie prosić Ducha Świętego o dar rozumu. Dar rozumu jest nieodzownie potrzebny do właściwego rozumienia bogactwa objawionej prawdy. Niech nasze serca nieustannie będą otwarte na Boże Słowo i jego prawdę. Wówczas zobaczymy i sami doświadczymy, że nie jest ono tylko i wyłacznie jakimś historycznym zapisem, kronika tego, się wydarzyło gdzieś w zamierzchłych czasach, nie jest jakimś echem dawno minionych lat, które niewyraźnie dochodzi do nas. Jest Słowem żywym – Słowem, które spotykamy na drodze naszego życia – Słowem, które wychodzi naprzeciw naszemu życiu i temu wszystkiemu, czego w nim doświadczamy. Nadaje sens naszemu życiu: temu co w nim najpiękniejsze, jak i temu, co najtrudniejsze, co niezrozumiałe. Słowo to nie jest bowiem nigdy stare, nigdy nieaktualne, wypełnione. Jest zawsze nowe, zawsze świeże, pełne siły, pobudzające nas na nowo, domagające się odpowiedzi – odpowiedzi danej swym życiem. Takie jest Słowo, które Bóg kieruje do każdego z nas; w którym Bóg przychodzi do każdego z nas; które nam ofiarowuje jako światło naszego życia. Przyjmijmy ten dar i nie zmarnujmy go, niech wydaje w naszym życiu obfity plon.

Każdy z nas chce, aby szkoła dostarczała wartości, które staramy się przekazać swoim dzieciom w domu, a także, aby te wartości były w dzieciach zakorzeniane i pielęgnowane. Szkoła katolicka uczy dzieci jasnego rozróżnienia pomiędzy dobrem a złem na fundamencie Ewangelii, nauki Kościoła i tradycji chrześcijańskiej. Nasza kadra nauczycielska wychowuje oraz wspomaga dzieci zarówno pod względem akademickim, moralnym jak i duchowym. Nauczanie wartości katolickich oraz wpajanie dzieciom sprawdzonych metod zdobywania wiedzy, zwłaszcza we wczesnych latach rozwoju jest naszą dumą i ale też i obowiązkiem.
