

Dear Parishioners,

Last week on September 29<sup>th</sup> we celebrated the feast of Saints Michael, Gabriel and Raphael, Archangels and on October 2<sup>nd</sup> we celebrated our Holy Guardian Angels. The existence of angels is a dogma of our Catholic Faith and is abundantly documented in Sacred Scriptures and Catholic Tradition. There are nine choirs of angels, and three hierarchies. These choirs and hierarchies are: first hierarchy - Angels, Archangels and Principalities; second hierarchy - Powers, Virtues and Dominions; and third hierarchy - Thrones, Cherubim and Seraphim

An angel is a spiritual creature, superior to human beings, with a three-fold mission: to praise God, to act as His messengers, and to watch over mortals. "What is man, that thou art mindful of him? ... For thou hast made him a little lower than the angels, and hast crowned him with glory and honor" (Psalm 8:4-5).

The name "angel" is from the Greek "angelos" meaning "one who is sent" or "messenger". Though purely spiritual, they can show themselves to men in human form as in the story of Tobias.

Passages in Scripture point to the existence of an angel specifically assigned to each human being to help, guide and protect him or her through the journey of life: "Behold I will send my angel, who shall go before thee, and keep thee in thy journey, and bring thee into the place that I have prepared. Take notice of him, and hear his voice" (Exodus 23:20)


And in the words of Our Lord Jesus Christ speaking of children: "See that you despise not one of these little ones: for I say to you that their angels in heaven always see the face of my Father who is in heaven." (Matthew 18:10).

So, each day let us take a little extra time to remember our guardian angels. In every difficulty, danger and temptation let us invoke our Guardian Angel. Let us ask them to offer our prayers to God with us and for us, and to help us know and live God's will in our lives. Let us also ask them to help us follow their example in constantly adoring God and caring for each other.

## Informacje parafialne





Aniołowie to istoty stworzone na obraz i podobieństwo Boże, które promieniują tym Bożym podobieństwem w wyższym stopniu od nas, stworzeń ludzkich. Jako duchy czyste, wolne od materii, nie są tak jak nasze dusze, uwiązane ani ograniczone przestrzenią. Poruszają się z szybkością myśli. Jako istoty duchowe nie są widzialni, więc mogą być przy nas w wielkiej ilości. I choć nie możemy ich dotknąć czy zobaczyć, to odczuwamy ich obecność, moc i opiekę.

W kalendarzu liturgicznym (29 września) wspominaliśmy przebywających w bliskości Boga Archaniołów: Michała - walczącego z szatanem obrońcę Izraela, Gabriela - przekazującego Boże orędzie oraz Rafała - opiekującego się chorymi i podróżnymi. Wszyscy trzej dani są nam ku pomocy w drodze do nieba, przez nich Bóg okazuje nam swoją potęgę i troskę. Jako chrześcijanie jesteśmy przeznaczeni do świętości, która jest ich udziałem, abyśmy wraz z nimi oddawali chwałę Bogu, wypełniając Jego wolę.

#### Modlitwa do św. Michała Archanioła

Święty Michale Archaniele, wspomagaj nas w walce, a przeciw niegodziwości zasadzkom złego ducha bądź naszą obroną. Oby go Bóg pogromić raczył, pokornie o to prosimy, a Ty, Wodzu niebieskich zastępów, szatana i inne duchy złe, które na zgubę dusz ludzkich po tym świecie krążą, mocą Bożą strąć do piekła. Amen.

#### Modlitwa do św. Rafała Archanioła

Święty Rafale Archaniele, który czuwasz przed majestatem Bożym i z polecenia Stwórcy, byłeś przewodnikiem w niebezpiecznej wędrówce Tobiasza. Czuwaj nad drogami naszego życia, ostrzegaj przed niebezpieczeństwami jakie nas zgubić mogą. Ty odpędzaleś demony i uzdrawialeś mocą Bożą. Broń nas przed uległością złu, a gdy zdrowie i życie nasze zagrożone będzie, wstawiaj się za nami u Boga, przedstawiaj nasze sprawy i bądź nam pomocny. Amen.

#### Modlitwa do św. Gabriela Archanioła

Święty Gabrielu Archaniele, który byłeś zawsze zwiastunem dobrej nowiny, dopomagaj nam do spokojnego przyjmowania wszelkich wieści. Byśmy nigdy nie ulegali panice, a zawsze umieli zaufać Bogu, którego łaską jesteśmy umocnieni. Przyczyniaj się także do tego, aby oznajmiana nam prawda stawała się dla nas jasna i zrozumiała, byśmy umieli przyjąć to, co Bóg w swej dobroci nam objawia. Amen.



2 października, obchodziliśmy wspomnienie świętych Aniołów Stróżów, istot duchowych, które posłane przez Boga, nieustannie nam towarzyszą. Według teologii opieka Anioła Stróża rozpoczyna się z chwilą narodzenia człowieka, a kończy z chwilą jego śmierci. Oni otrzymali misję, aby nas prowadzić, ochraniać, upominać, pomagać w nawróceniu, wspierać w wykonywaniu powierzonych nam zadań, bronić w momentach niebezpieczeństw i pokus. Nasz Anioł Stróż jest uosobieniem Opatrzności Boskiej w stosunku do każdego z nas osobno. Od pierwszej chwili naszego życia na ziemi do niego należy przewidywanie i usuwanie rozlicznych niebezpieczeństw, które zewsząd nam zagrażają, a które mogłyby nam przeszkodzić w osiągnięciu celu, dla którego zostaliśmy stworzeni. Zanoszą nasze modlitwy do Boga i wstawiając się za nami, przyczyniają się do naszego zbawienia. Przyzywajmy więc wytrwale i z ufnością każdego dnia naszych Świętych Aniołów Stróżów.

#### Modlitwa do Anioła Stróża



Pope Benedict XVI in an address at the Basilica of St. Mary Major where he prayed the rosary with the faithful said:


Today, together we confirm that the Holy Rosary is not a pious practice banished to the past, like prayers of other times thought of with nostalgia. Instead, the Rosary is experiencing a new Springtime. Without a doubt, this is one of the most eloquent signs of love that the young generation nourish for Jesus and his Mother, Mary. In the current world, so dispersive, this prayer helps to put Christ at the centre, as the Virgin did, who meditated within all that was said about her Son, and also what he did and said. When reciting the Rosary, the important and meaningful moments of salvation history are relived. The various steps of Christ's mission are traced. With Mary the heart is oriented toward the mystery of Jesus. Christ is put at the centre of our life, of our time, of our city, through the contemplation and meditation of his holy mysteries of joy, light, sorrow and glory. May Mary help us to welcome within ourselves the grace emanating from these mysteries, so that through us we can "water" society, beginning with our daily relationships, and purifying them from so many negative forces, thus opening them to the newness of God. The Rosary, when it is prayed in an authentic way, not mechanical and superficial but profoundly, it brings, in fact, peace and reconciliation. It contains within itself the healing power of the Most Holy Name of Jesus, invoked with faith and love at the centre of each "Hail Mary".

#### The Mysteries of the Rosary

Until about the 15th century hundreds of mysteries were part of the Rosary devotion then the 15 mysteries that we know today were definitively fixed as "the Mysteries of the Rosary." Pope John Paul II, in his encyclical, Rosarium Virginis Mariae, in 2002 added the five Luminous Mysteries.

Through the meditations of the complete Rosary, one recalls and has impressed on his mind, the Popes tell us, "the chief mysteries of the Christian religion," "the mysteries of our Redemption," "the great mysteries of Jesus and His Mother united in joys, sorrows, and triumphs." The twenty mysteries are divided into four equal groups, known as "The Joyful," "The Sorrowful," "The Glorious," and "The Luminous Mysteries."
