Epiphany Blessing of a Home

All make the Sign of the Cross +
Head of Household: "Peace be to this house and to all who dwell here, in the name of the Lord.
All: Blessed be God forever.
Reader: In the beginning was the Word and the Word was with God. He was in the beginning with God. All things come to be through Him, and without Him nothing came to be... And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we saw His GLory, the Glory of the Father's only Son, full of grace and truth. (John 1:1-3,14)

Using blessed chalk, write on the outside of your house above or next to the entrance:
20 + C + M + B + 25
 Meaning: Christus Mansionem Benedicat - May Christ Bless this House
 Or Caspar, Melchior and Balthazar, the names of the three kings.

Recite the Our Father together. Let us Pray:
Leader: Hear us, O Holy Lord, Father Almighty, Eternal God, and send Thy Holy Angel from Heaven to watch over, cherish, protect, be with, and defend all who live in my house. I call upon Your Saint, Caspar, Melchior and Balthazar, to protect my family and my home from every harm and danger, and I place the marks of their holy names over the door of my home to remain there as a constant reminder to us and to all who enter here that my house is truly a house of the Lord.

O God, make the door of my house wide enough to receive all who need human love and companionship; narrow enough to shut out all envy, pride and strife. Make its threshold smooth enough to be no stumbling block to children, nor to straying feet, but rugged and strong enough to turn back the tempter's power.

O God, make the door of my house a gateway to Thy eternal Kingdom. I ask these things in the name of Jesus Christ Thy Son. **All: Amen.**

Following the above prayers, the family moves from room to room asking a blessing on the rest of the home. The oldest child sprinkles the holy water from a bowl using a sprig of evergreen, while the father asks the blessing, "In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen."

Missionary Discipleship—January 5: Solemnity of the Epiphany of the Lord Welcoming and Hospitality

Two key components of Evangelization are being welcoming and providing radical hospitality. The Gospel today provides a great example of both welcoming and hospitality. The wise men traveled a very long distance to show welcome and hospitality to the "newborn King of the Jews." They provided generous gifts and gave Him homage. Mary and Joseph welcomed the strangers and presented a beautiful example of radical hospitality. Mary and Joseph were probably still extremely tired from their own journey from Nazareth to Bethlehem and from the anxiety of giving birth to a baby in a manger. However, they realized they were called to share Jesus with others and they did. How do you show welcoming and radical hospitality? When was the last time you shared Jesus with others?


