Long term case management, asset building, and resource coordination services are provided to individuals and families in need; along with life skills training, GED classes, job training and monthly education programs.

### **St. Martha's Hall and Kathy J. Weinman Shelter -**

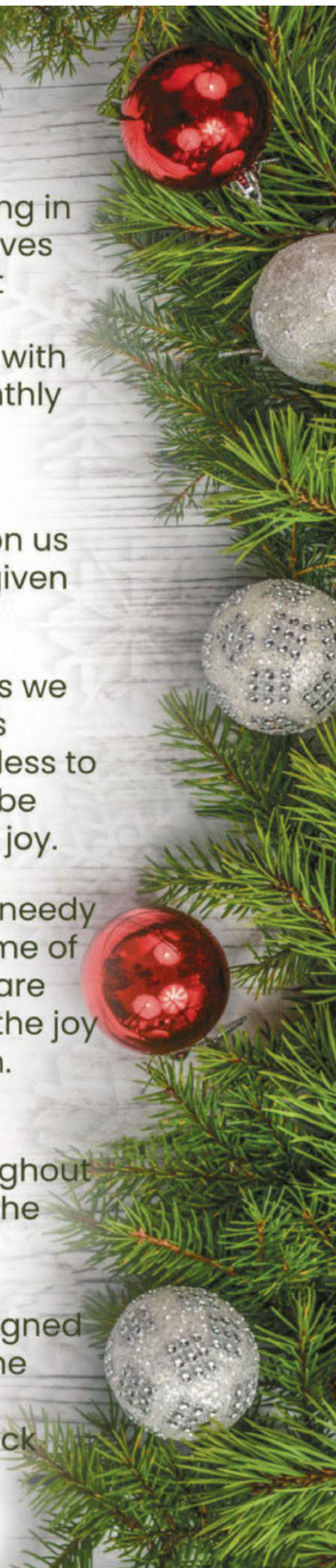
Shelters for abused women and children that rely on us for supplies to run their centers and for gifts to be given at Christmas to their residents.

**Sts. Peter and Paul Community Services -** The gifts we collect go directly to the residents in their homeless shelter and those who have graduated from homeless to assisted living. For most of these residents, this will be their only gift this Christmas and it truly gives them joy.

**St. Vincent DePaul Society -** The Society helps the needy that live within our parish boundaries, including some of our own parishioners. Grocery and store gift cards are given to the families with the intent of giving them the joy of shopping for their families this Christmas season.

**St. Wenceslaus Food Pantry -** Run by Holy Infant parishioners, the pantry uses these gift cards throughout the year to purchase meat and dairy products for the clients they serve.

**Wellston Center Christmas Club -** A program designed to give the poorest residents in the Wellston area the dignity and joy of shopping for their own gifts at a fraction of the cost. All proceeds are fed directly back into the program for the following year.

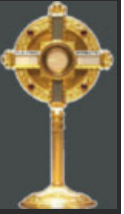

## **Eucharistic Miracles Throughout History**

### **Scientifically Confirmed | Lanciano, Italy**

In the 8th century, an Italian monk had doubts while saying Mass. As he said the words of consecration, the host visibly changed into cardiac tissue and the wine became physical blood. This miracle has been studied by modern scientists, who have concluded that there is no natural explanation. DNA indicates the flesh is from the middle east matching the genetics and blood type recovered from the Shroud of Turin.

### **The Waters Parted | Avignon, France**

The Chapel of the Holy Cross had the Eucharist exposed during the massive 1433 flood. The water in the church was 4 feet high, but the center aisle remained completely dry, creating a clear path to the Eucharist.

### **An Army, Defeated | Assisi, Italy**

In September of 1240, the Saracen Army stormed the convent of the Poor Ladies of San Damiano, now known as the Poor Clares. Though frail at the time, St. Clare carried the Blessed Sacrament before the army and cried out to Jesus for protection. The soldiers were struck with fear and retreated at the sight of the Sacred Heart.

### **A Living Person | Baltimore, Maryland**

On his 1995 visit to the U.S., Pope John Paul II asked to visit the Blessed Sacrament at Saint Mary's Seminary chapel. His security personnel brought in trained dogs to sweep the area. The dogs indicated that a living person was in the Tabernacle and refused to leave!
