SISTERS IN CHRIST,

DEAR BROTHERS & Before all else, I want to congratulate our second graders who have just made their First Reconciliation! We are so proud and thankful for you! We have moved First Reconciliation to within two weeks of First Holy Communion to help our

students better understand the beautiful reality of Luke 15:7....of how Our Lord and all of the angels in heaven rejoice over one sinner who repents. In fact so much so, that like the father of the prodigal son, God reacts to our hearts' reunification with His heart by throwing the Wedding Feast at which Christ the Lamb offers Himself. Repentance is the road to rejoicing.

We ourselves are drawn into the heart of the same Paschal mystery. We have made it to Palm Sunday weekend and we are in the final stretch towards of Lent, and now we head into Holy Week, the Sacred Triduum (Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Holy Saturday), and Easter itself. This is the holiest week of the year. It is a great time to spend more effort in prayer and to enter into the mystery of Christ's Passion for us.

This is my first Holy Thursday as pastor and after asking the parish council, they have agreed to let me wash their feet as representatives of all of St. Clare. Now, there are a few different schools of thought on foot washing and I would say they all have their own place. The traditional practice was the feet of twelve men, as Christ did at the Last Supper. In the time of Moses and Aaron, part of the ordination ritual included a ritual bath to prepare them to serve at the altar. The church has always understood the Last Supper to be the foundation of the institution of the Mass, but also the institution of the priesthood. He begins it with that foot washing and later prays the most beautiful prayer of consecration. So, the practice of washing only men's feet brings to mind the origin of the priesthood of Jesus Christ. In recent years, Pope Francis became the first pope to wash the feet of women and in doing so formally gave permission to a practice which had already become pretty common in many parishes. In these cases, the focus of the foot washing was understandably shifted from calling to mind



the priesthood to calling to mind the general aspect of Christ's humble service, who came not to be served, but to serve and to give His life as a ransom for many. Jesus tells His disciples, that as He has done this for them, they should go and do likewise. Thankfully, millions of men and women have both served humbly in Christ's Name. However, Jesus also speaks of the washing in relationship to having a "part" in Him – that is, an inheritance. Since His disciples have already been bathed (in baptism) they need only their feet to be washed to be clean all over. In other words, He is forgiving them and they should go and do likewise – that is – forgive the people who have carelessly brought the dirt of their lives into the lives of His disciples. May all of us be empowered to forgive our brothers and sisters who have wronged us in any way. We will have a greater share or "part" in Christ's mercy when we embrace the mercy He wants to share with others through us.

Good Friday will offer you an opportunity to return to Our Lord for your own reconciliation to perhaps stir up that mercy for others. We will have three



The Seven Churches Pilgrimage is a Holy Thursday tradition in which Catholics visit seven different churches to pray before the Blessed Sacrament. This practice commemorates Jesus' journey on the night of His Passion, from the Last Supper to His arrest in the Garden of Gethsemane



and the various places He was taken before His crucifixion. Each stop allows for reflection on Christ's suffering and an reflection on Christ's suffering and an opportunity for personal prayer, particularly in front of the altar of repose, where the Eucharist is placed after the Holy Thursday Mass. The devotion originated in Rome, where pilgrims would visit the seven major basilicas, and it has since spread to many parts of the world.






