



FROM THE DESK OF FATHER BILL...

Fr. Scott Jones had been very diligent last September when he called and asked when I thought I would be ready to be 'officially installed' as Pastor of the Sacred Heart Community of parishes. I think I was averaging about 300 meetings a day at that point, and the "drinking from the firehose" experience was at its peak. (Okay, 300 is a slight exaggeration...) I asked if we could wait until things 'settle down a bit'. So, after 7 months of being here, he called back and asked when he could get the job done. I will be officially installed as Pastor on Pentecost Sunday – at the 9am Mass. It seemed a fitting a date – not only as the one-year anniversary of the All Things New plan being announced – but as the birthday of the church with the outpouring of the Holy Spirit. I look forward to the continued outpouring of the Spirit upon this Sacred Heart community of faith as I join the ranks of some very wonderful and holy men who were privileged to serve as pastor here. We will mark the event with the "transferred feast of Coffee and Donuts" from the first Sunday of May (conflicting with the Valley of the Flowers hoopla) to the 19th. Our BTC family has decided not to host a pancake breakfast for the month of May.

Speaking of that, let this be a reminder about the Pancake breakfast this weekend HERE at Sacred Heart for the first time. As you know, this is one of the fundraisers for Blessed Teresa School of Sacred Heart parish. It will be my first experience of what I am told is a pretty amazing culinary happening. I hope to see many of you there, from 7:30am to 11am.

A HUGE word of thanks to all who came on Saturday to help clean out the rectory and the convent at the Philippine Duchesne Center. What a difference before and after. Though the religious articles (some candlesticks, old lectionaries and sacramentaries, a tabernacle, a set of stations of the cross, etc.) still need to be taken to the reclamation center (only open on Wednesdays), all that is left is a bit of dusting and sweeping of the carpets and floors, and a good clean of all the surfaces, and the rectory will be ready for business. [The convent, on the other hand, still has some work to do...] Now, the backside of that clean out begins – with the Garage Sale folks sorting all those items, plus those arriving on a weekly, if not daily basis. So, a huge word of thanks to Theresa Brandt and her intrepid crew. And if you enjoy that kind of work – getting items ready for their second life (or third or fourth or...) give her a call at 314-303-1720.

So, a bit about **Room at the Inn**, the folks who, hopefully, will be renting out the rectory while their space near the DePaul Hospital complex is being renovated. *Room at the Inn was founded in 1993 and initially sponsored by the Sisters of Divine Providence. We are a 501(c)(3) non-profit agency incorporated in Missouri. Over the past 30 years we have partnered with more than 50 interfaith congregations representing 15 faith traditions and a wide range of socioeconomic backgrounds. We collaborate with multiple outside agencies to make needed services available for our clients. ROOM catalyzes to help our community help those who are homeless.*

Their goal is to provide assistance to those who find themselves temporarily out of housing. *People who come to Room at the Inn (ROOM) work with us to create a plan of action designed specifically for their unique needs and goals. Our support may include life skills education, counseling, employment readiness training, parenting class, or access to medical, mental health, dental, and vision care. We do everything we can to positively impact the physical, mental, and emotional health of every client who enters our doors.* All clients go through a screening process, enter an intense program designed to get them back into permanent housing as soon as possible, and are mentored every step of the way. A quick visit to their website lists the services that they are provided with. Like the Vincent De Paul Society's work with the hungry and poor, they do an amazing job with one of the corporal works of mercy – that of sheltering the homeless. It is a blessing and a participation in that work of mercy for the parish to provide this space for them.

Some have asked: "**Will this be a permanent thing?**" No, just while construction is going on at their Bridgeton site. The Pandemic forced a change in their model. They could no longer take clients to the different sponsoring church sites (St. Rose Philippine Duchesne was one of the sites) each night for dinner, some fellowship, and a good night's sleep before they were taken back to receive their support services. The pandemic prohibited that shuffling from place to place, and the city of Bridgeton granted them an emergency variance to stay in their current building. 2 ½ years later, it became clear that staying in one place yielded better long term outcomes. So, their model has changed, but their mission remains the same: to get families back into a stable, permanent housing situation. God willing, and the construction goes well, they will be back at the Bridgeton site in 6-9 months.


TUESDAY MORNING GARDEN GROUP


