The Pastor's Column

Greetings St. Simon Parishioners,

Knowing that you have received a couple of formal letters from me regarding the administrative changes at the two schools, I am writing this letter with my heavy heart. A heart that has been hurt by what has happened the last two weeks or so to our entire community. This past week and a half have been trying for all of us, especially for those in the day school and Simon Says. Thank you for voicing your concern and demonstrating your passion for St. Simon the Apostle Parish and School. As I am sure you are aware, Michele Snyder and Erin Lawrence will no longer be serving in their positions. Additionally, Alex Forestel resigned from his position as director of youth ministry among his other roles in the parish. I have heard from many of you asking for details and or clarification of the situation.

First, however, I would like to apologize for the turmoil that has resulted from the timing of my confidential communication. The delivery of my message during my leave/recovery from surgery was not well thought out, as I was not available to talk or be seen in the immediate aftermath and for that I ask your forgiveness. I am truly sorry in real time to see in real time how this has impacted our entire community.

I am aware that for many I have lost your trust as you are sad, angry, and looking for answers. This is a difficult pill to swallow, but I respect your thoughts and position on the matter as everyone is entitled to one. The scars and pain from this past week are all too familiar going back through the past decade with the trials of losing many students and having to go through the All-Things New process. Nonetheless, I want to continue to earn your trust, though I know I have a massive mountain to climb.

As your Pastor, I humbly ask you to not turn against your parish and school and all that we stand for together. Please continue to bring your kids to Simon Says and/or St. Simon School. Please do not let this situation hinder your decision to enroll your kids for next school year nor prevent you from attending Masses. Just this past week we had a family enroll two children in the day school. Yes, this is a small example, but we continue to take it one day at a time. We are on the path to becoming a stronger parish and we can only do that together. I love and want what's best for this parish and school community though many believe this is not the case. I was not assigned to the parish and school to close them. Thank-you for taking the time to read my column. I am available to meet with you to discuss your concerns.

On another note, this coming Wednesday is Ash Wednesday and the beginning of lent. We will have Ash Wednesday Masses at 8am for the day school and 7pm for the entire parish in the evening. We also have our first fish fry which will be starting at 4pm. There will be plenty of food for you and your family. I look forward to seeing you there.

Know of my prayers for you. Please pray for me.

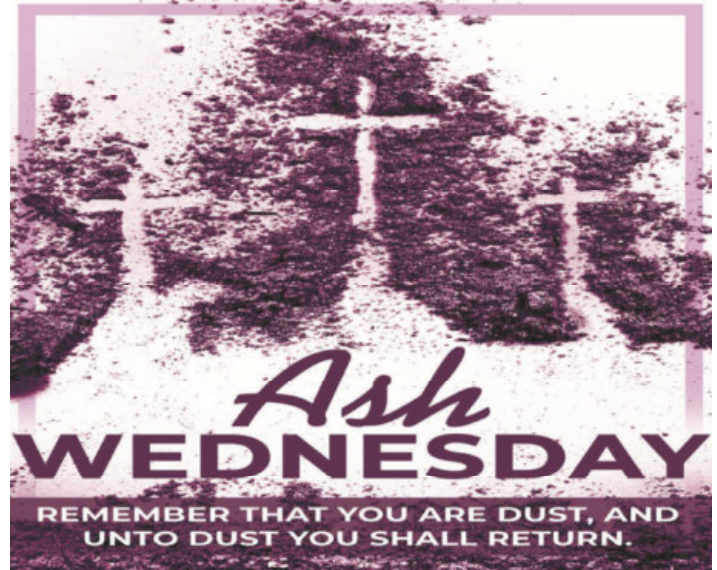

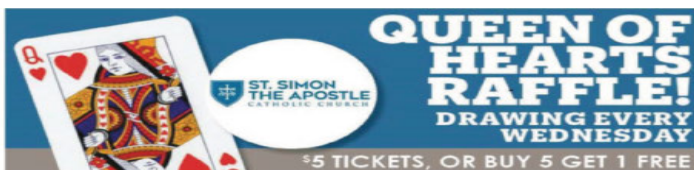

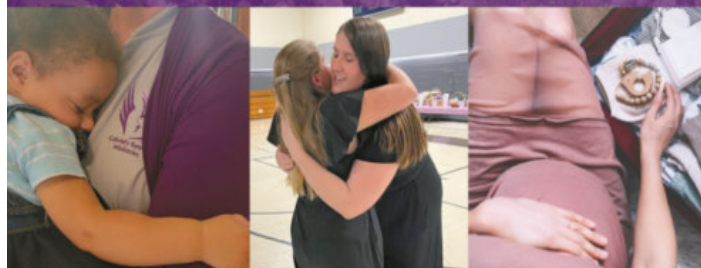
Please join us on Tuesday, **March 11**, for our

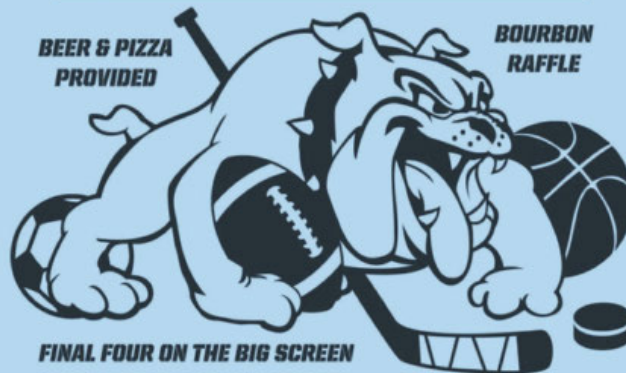

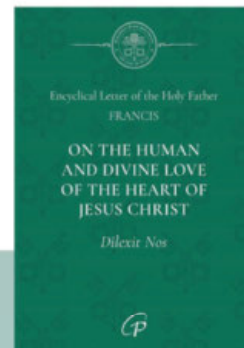
