Now Accepting Parish Council Nominations!

Hello parishioners,

As summer begins, we conclude another year of service for our current Parish Council members. We are looking for nominations for 4 new parish council members to serve the parish. We wanted to open nominations to the whole parish.

What is a parish council? The parish council is an advisory council that helps the pastor make decisions about the parish. The members give advice regarding any major decision that affects parishioners, keeps the pastor informed about things important to the parish, and helps shape the vision, mission, and direction of the parish.

This year our parish council provided insights, feedback, and advice regarding the celebration of the Mass, FORMED and its use in our parish, start time for the Good Friday Service, discussion about a Picture Directory, assistance with foster-care, and more.

What should new members expect at meetings? Meetings will include a time of prayer, a time of formation, and then a time for business, discussion, and decision making.

Who can become a parish council member? Any registered parishioner 18 or older, who has received the Sacraments of initiation (Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Communion), regularly attends Mass on Sundays (or Saturday evening) and Holy Days of Obligation, goes to confession at least once a year, has a personal prayer life, has a manner of life that is in harmony with the faith and the role to be undertaken, and if married, the marriage is canonically valid and recognized as such by the Catholic Church. Use of email and text messaging is important for council member communication.

How is someone nominated? Nominations are communicated to current parish council members, or directly to Fr. Lampe. Nominations can be made by email, phone call, note, or letter. Nominations made by paper can be placed in the collection basket, dropped off at the parish office, or mailed to the parish office. All parishioners who are nominated need to accept the nomination.

What happens next? If more people accept their nominations than we have openings for new members, then an election will take place.

After reading today's gospel, I thought, "Man, I'm glad I'm not preaching this Sunday".

So I'm going to focus on Saint Paul's letter to the Corinthians. In it, he writes, "Although our outer self is wasting away, our inner self is being renewed day by day. For this momentary light affliction is producing for us an eternal weight of glory beyond all comparison. For what is seen is transitory, but what is unseen is eternal."

Saint Paul is telling us that this life that we're living is fading away. We have this opportunity to use this time on earth to bring us to our eternal reward. We all have a purpose. We are called to use it.

As human beings, we will be going through trials and afflictions throughout our lifetime. But as Saint Pope John Paul II stated that when we can take our sufferings and unite them with Christ, we share in Christ's redemptive work on earth for the good of the Church and for the whole world.

Christ allows us to share in that redemptive work because he wants us to share in his joy.

Saint Paul calls it a momentary light affliction, but many of us are going through sufferings that are not light. That is where, we, as members of the church are called to pray, and to assist whenever possible. This affliction is producing for us an eternal weight of glory beyond all comparison. For what we see is transitory, but what is unseen is eternal.

30 PRAYER DAYS FOR LIFE

Our parish will observe a Day of Prayer for Life on Tuesday, June 11, during our regular adoration hours. All participants are asked to include the intention of keeping Missouri a pro-life state during their prayers before the Blessed Sacrament, including a special request for the Blessed Mother's intercession. Other parishioners are asked to come pray before the Blessed Sacrament any time during the day for this intention. The archdiocese has requested parishes adopt a day of prayer since the pro-abortion groups have submitted enough signatures to put an initiative on the November ballot. This initiative will erase all pro-life legislation in Missouri and make abortion legal all nine months of pregnancy. Our Secretary of State is currently in the process of validating that all signatures are valid. Please continue your prayers that the initiative is not on the ballot but, if so, we defeat this extreme measure soundly.
