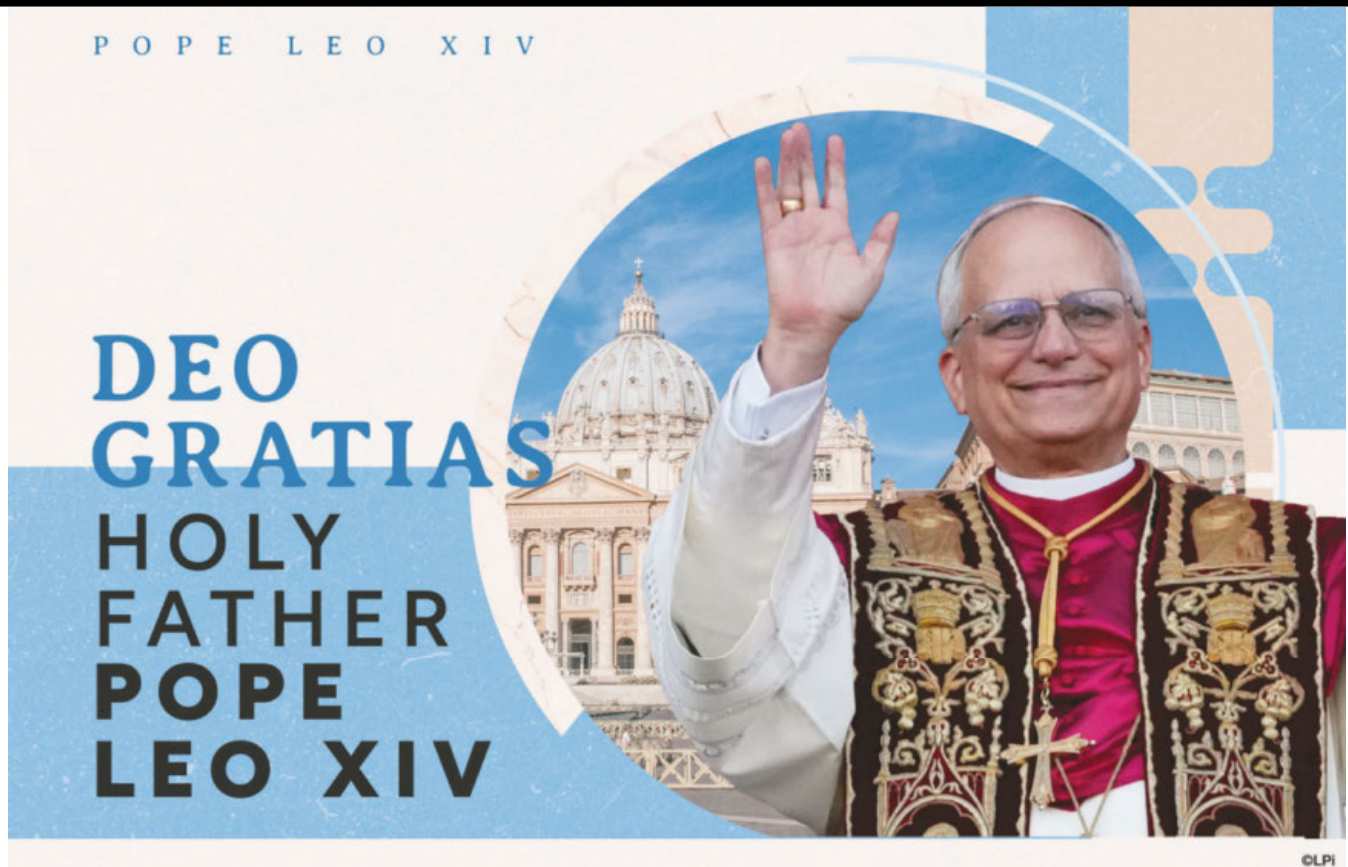

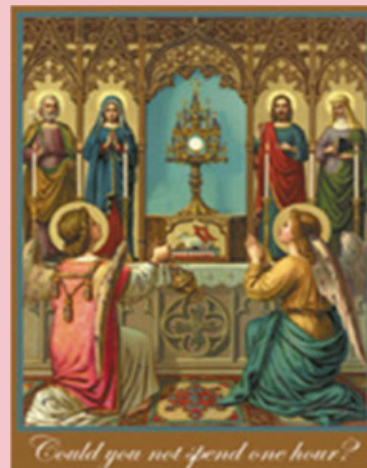

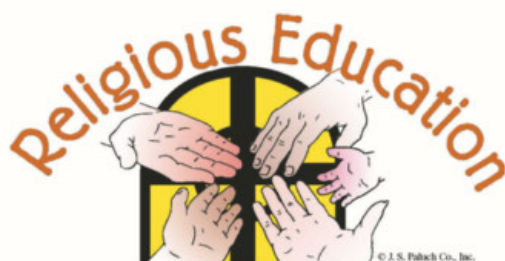

SYMBOLS FROM THE CEILING OF THE SACRED HEART CHAPEL



KNOWING GOD THROUGH SACRED ART

If you are standing at the altar, looking out toward the pews, you will see this medallion in the center of the fourth bay of artwork. This is clearly a depiction of the 10 Commandments which were given to Moses on Mount Sinai. You may wonder why the numbers are not evenly distributed on each tablet. That is to show the difference between these sets of commandments. The first three commandments are all about God. They are as follows (in layman's terms): do not commit idolatry (or put anything before God), do not use God's name in vain, and make holy the Sabbath day (which for us means going to Mass every Sunday). Commandments four through ten are about our brothers and sisters in Christ. They are as follows (in layman's terms): honor your mother and father, do not kill, do not commit adultery, do not steal, do not lie, do not covet (or jealously desire) someone's possessions, do not covet someone's wife (or any other person).

God did not give us the commandments to limit our freedom. Rather, He revealed these moral truths to help us live a good life. Sin always causes damage to our relationship with God. It also hurts others and ourselves. God wants to protect us from this damage. He wants us to live in accordance with the good nature that He created us in. God does not make stupid rules. Even if we struggle to understand all the moral teachings that God has revealed to us through the scriptures and His Church, we should trust that they are for our own good. While some might see Catholic morality as oppressive, in reality, God is protecting us from enslavement to sin. He values our freedom even more than we do. Following the commandments and turning to the sacrament of reconciliation anytime we seriously fall, will allow us to freely follow God and truly love others.

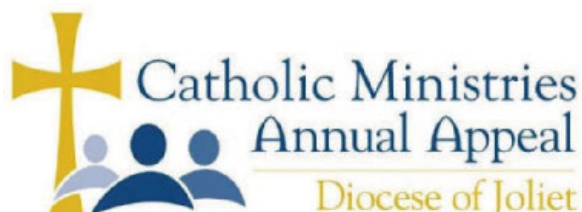

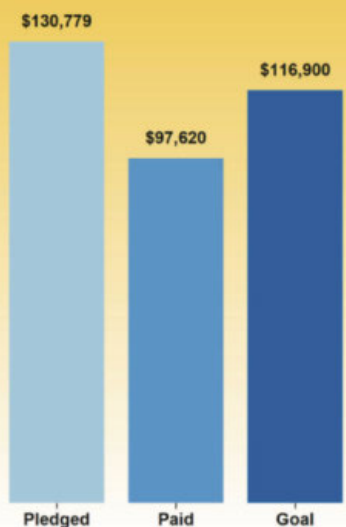
