



SHOP-SES

**SHOP-SES cards are NOT only for holidays. –
You can use them throughout the year.**

SHOP-SES is a pre-paid card program in which the parish can purchase store gift cards at a discount. By selling the cards at face value, the parish can generate additional funds without costing the parishioners additional money. Last year over **\$2,500** was raised thru this program. Cards are used as cash at the various stores. All you need to do is purchase them prior to making your regular purchases. 
The Feast of the Baptism of the Lord

Our Catholic Home Tradition for January is understanding and engaging in the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord. **The liturgical Christmas season ends with the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord on January 13.** During Advent, we heard the prophet St. John the Baptist herald the coming of Christ. Today we heard how Jesus allowed Himself to be baptized by John.


When Christ was baptized, the Heavens opened and God the Father spoke, revealing to the world that Jesus is His Son. Fittingly, it is through our Baptisms that we become adopted sons and daughters of the Father, and that Heaven is opened to us.

On the day we were baptized, we made promises (or our parents made them on our behalf). At their core, our baptismal promises are about following Jesus on the path to Heaven.



Sharing the Gospel
