NO Confessions on Holy Thursday or Easter Vigil

The nursery will **not** be open for Holy Thursday, Good Friday, Easter Vigil or Easter Sunday.

The DIVINE MERCY NOVENA will conclude on **Sunday, April 16**, at 3:00 p.m. The service is Bilingual, and a potluck will follow.

FASTING, ABSTINENCE & PENANCE

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast and abstinence. The law of fasting allows one full meal and two smaller ones that do not together equal one full meal. The law of abstinence prohibits the eating of meat. The **Fridays of Lent** are days of abstinence in the United States. The obligation of abstinence begins at age 14. The law of fasting obliges all between the ages of 18-59. Pastors and parents are to see to it that minors, though not bound by the law of fast and abstinence, are educated in the authentic sense of penance and encouraged to do acts of penance suitable to their age. All members of the Christian faithful are encouraged to do acts of penance and charity during the Lenten season beyond what is prescribed by the law.

AYUNO, ABSTINENCIA Y PENITENCIA

El **Miércoles de Ceniza** y el **Viernes Santo** son días de ayuno y abstinencia. La Ley del ayuno permite una comida fuerte y dos sencillas. La ley de la abstinencia prohíbe comer carne. Los **Viernes de Cuaresma** son días de abstinencia en los Estados Unidos. La abstinencia comienza a los 14 años de edad. La ley del ayuno es para todas las personas entre los 18 y los 59 años de edad. Tanto los Sacerdotes como los Padres de familia deberán de enseñar a los menores de edad que, aunque no puedan ayunar, deberán comprender el verdadero sentido de la penitencia y están obligados a realizar actos de penitencia de acuerdo a su edad. Todos y cada uno de los miembros de la fe Cristiana estamos obligados a hacer actos de penitencia y caridad durante la Cuaresma más allá de lo que está escrito en la ley.

JESUS, I TRUST IN YOU!



As we begin to move into the season of Lent and prepare our hearts for the Resurrection of our Lord on Easter, we then look towards Divine Mercy Sunday celebrated on April 16th.

In St. Faustina's Diary Jesus tells her: "I promise that the soul that will venerate this image will not perish. I also promise victory over its enemies already here on earth, especially at the hour of death. I Myself will defend it as My own glory." (Diary 48)

St Faustina then writes: "When I told this to my confessor, I received this for a reply: "That refers to your soul." He told me, "Certainly, paint God's image in your soul." When I came out of the confessional, I again heard words such as these: My image already is in your soul. I desire that there be a Feast of Mercy. I want this image, which you will paint with a brush, to be solemnly blessed on the first Sunday after Easter; that Sunday is to be the Feast of Mercy." (Diary 49)

Al comenzar la Cuaresma, y preparar nuestros corazones para la Resurrección de Nuestro Señor en Pascua, podemos vislumbrar el Domingo de la Divina Misericordia, celebrado este año el 16 de abril.

En el Diario de Santa Faustina, Jesús le dice: "Yo prometo al alma que venere esta Imagen que no perecerá. También prometo, ya aquí en la tierra, la victoria sobre los enemigos y, sobre todo, a la hora de la muerte. Yo, el Señor, la protegeré como a Mi propia Gloria" (Diario, 48)

Santa Faustina escribe después que cuando le dijo a su confesor, él respondió que eso era pertinente a su alma y que ciertamente podía pintar una imagen de Dios en su alma, pero cuando salió del confesionario volvió a escuchar estas palabras: "Mi imagen ya está en tu alma. Deseo que haya una Fiesta de la Misericordia. Quiero que esta imagen que pintarás con el pincel sea bendecida con solemnidad el primer domingo después de la Pascua de Resurrección; ese domingo debe ser la Fiesta de la Misericordia". (Diario, 49)

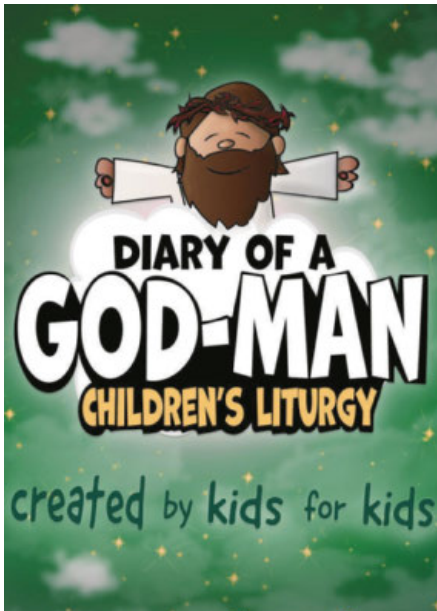

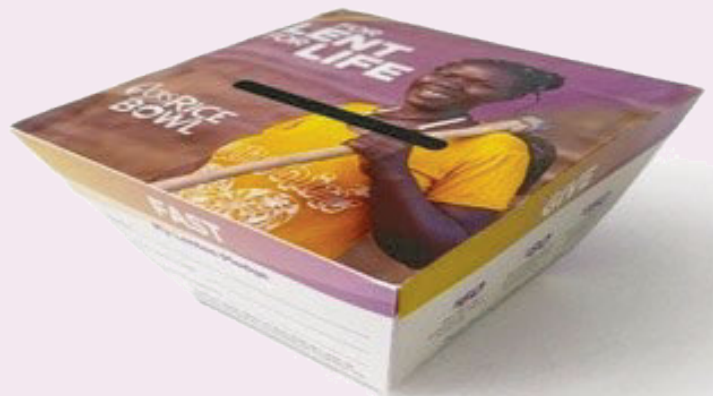
