







Dear Parishioners and Friends of St. Ambrose Parish Family,

This weekend, the Easter Season of fifty days comes to an end with the celebration of **Pentecost**, often called the "**Birthday of the Church**" because it was when the Holy Spirit entered the hearts of the early followers of Jesus that they had the courage to proclaim the Good News. 

Both Entrées will feature German Potato Salad, and Red Cabbage sautéed in Hermann Red Wine – Tea, Lemonade, or Coffee w/ Peach Pecan bread pudding dessert. Please indicate your sandwich choice w/your reservation. Next on our tour will be a wine taste at the Hermanoff Winery. Here you will hear more history of wine country and enjoy the taste of the town with several offerings of the Hermanoff products. Our last stop on this whirlwind tour will be to visit with the Mayor of Hermann at the Historic Fire Company



St. Ambrose Student Service Hour Policy Finalized | Our School Board is putting final edits to a policy for student service hours. Beginning with the 2024-2025 school year, St. Ambrose students will be expected to complete service hours. The expectation will be the corresponding number as to their grade. 8th graders will need to complete 8 hours of service, 7th grade will complete 7 hours on down. There are many types of service students could compete here at St. Ambrose and in the community. We are working on a digital submission platform for these student service hours. This platform will also be used for parent/family service hours. This digital submission system will be in place before the start of the 2024-2025 school year. Students and parents wanting to complete service this Summer can track those hours and then submit at the end of the Summer when our system is ready for use. Once the final wording of the policy is completed, it will be shared with parents. Opportunities for service include: Altar Server, Usher, Choir (Sundays this Fall with new Music Director), Musician, Lector, Worship Aid, Vacation Bible School Helper, Father Steve's helpers, as well as after Mass opportunities like; Clean up, Wash and dry vessels, Collection in bags, Check outreach containers, Fold/staple, Bind seasonal hymn book, Put ribbons in new missalettes, Wrapping around Christmas/Easter gift books, Sorting items.
