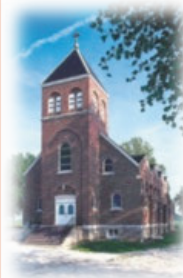

Prayer & Reflection

Fourteenth Sunday of Ordinary Time
July 6

Reading I: Isaiah 66:10-14

The last part of the book of Isaiah contains the words of a prophet who lived after the Jews returned from exile in Babylon. In today's reading (which is a poem), the prophet sees a bright future for Jerusalem, and uses the image of God as a mother.

Reading II: Galatians 6:14-18

In Galatia, a group of Christians attacked Paul's credentials as an apostle and accused him of false teaching because he said people can be saved without abiding by the Jewish law. In this passage from the end of his letter to the Galatians, Paul defends his right to teach, and stresses that faith in the law has been replaced by faith in Jesus.

Gospel: Luke 10:1-12, 17-20

For centuries God's people longed for a messiah. They yearned for someone who would bring about God's reign, a time of peace and blessings. The prophets had an unshakable faith in God's reign and communicated that confidence to the people. It is this reign that Jesus preached and began. He commissions the seventy-two disciples to proclaim the coming of this reign. The peace of God's reign is made possible through Jesus' life, death and resurrection. It is the fulfillment of all humanity's hopes. The disciples are successful because they are agents of God's grace. That they have been chosen as instruments of that grace is the real reason for rejoicing.

Life Focus:

1. How does Jesus ask you to spread the gospel in the world today? What obstacles do you see in your path? What do you need to do to overcome these obstacles?
2. When have you felt like a lamb walking among wolves?
3. What instructions that you received early in your faith life are still valid and useful today?

Some Say

Catholic - Beneath the Surface

At first, the Apostles try to dodge the question.

When Jesus confronts them — and make no mistake, it is a confrontation — with the question “Who do you say that I am?” they act like a man whose wife has just asked him if she looks fat in these jeans.

The evasiveness of their answer puts politicians to shame: “Some say John the Baptist, others Elijah, still others Jeremiah or one of the prophets.”

Some say.

But Jesus doesn't let them off easy. He repeats himself. He wants an answer. “Who do you say that I am?”

They all know the answer. They all believe the answer. And they all know the answer could get them thrown in prison or killed. Only Peter is brave enough to say it: “You are the Christ, the Son of the Living God.”

People have a lot of opinions about God. They always have. They have a lot of opinions about Jesus and the Bible, about the Catholic Church and the Pope. Some of these opinions are well-founded, well-researched. Some of them are based in ignorance. Many are born of painful misunderstandings. But they are all just that: opinions.

Some say.

We know who Jesus is. We know who the Eucharist is. We know what the truth is. Amid the chaos and the violence and the excruciating *loudness* of this fallen world and all the words it shouts into the void about God and Jesus and right and wrong, *we know*.

But will we answer?

Students must attend 5 days per week, with the flexibility to choose from full days, half days, or a combination of both to best suit your family's needs.

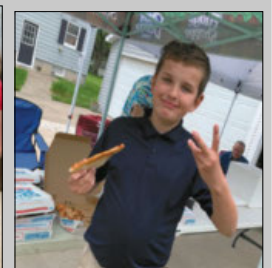


