





### An Excerpt from Pastor's Desk....!

**"Whether he is asleep or awake,  
be it day or night,  
the seed sprouts and grows; he  
knows not how."**

In the first reading, Ezekiel prophesies how God will raise up the weak and the insignificant and make them fruitful. Saint Paul, in the second reading, writes that *we must walk by faith, not by sight*, and we must appear before the *judgment seat of Christ*. So, our mission is to do what pleases God and God alone. The Kingdom of God works mysteriously and incrementally only to become the anchor for the entire life on earth.

The Kingdom is not the result of human enterprise; it is God's handiwork. None of our human efforts can produce the kingdom; rather, it is the invisible, a mysterious unfolding of God's plan in His time, which will incrementally and eventually grow into its promised fullness. The Lord Jesus uses the images of the Sower and the mustard seed to explain the kingdom of God. Although seemingly insignificant, but it demonstrates that great things can happen through the work of God.

As disciples of Christ, our task is to be grateful witnesses of this and let God's Kingdom unfold *in and through us*, though not necessarily by us. It must grow to become like Ezekiel's lofty cedar tree, which is full of fruits. For as a mystery, it keeps unfolding and it will require an openness of heart on our part. This implies that while we are called to participate in the realization of the God's kingdom on earth, it is God who will fully establish his own kingdom in the end. The full realization of his kingdom is a gift to be received by all of us. It can even be received by those of us who, at first did not want to participate but eventually decided to do so.

We pray that God may grant us the grace to be open as his kingdom unfolds in our life. Amen.


