The Baptism of the Lord, Sunday, January 9, 2022. Why did Jesus, the all-holy Son of God, seek John's baptism of repentance? It was not to receive—for he is himself the source of all grace—but to give. "Christ is baptized, not to be made holy by the water, but to make the water holy, and by his cleansing to purify the waters which he touched" (Saint Maximus of Turin). Christ's baptism reveals to us what our own baptism now accomplishes: the forgiveness of sin and a share in his divine sonship. Dear Friends of Epiphany School,

God's blessings to you as we begin the new year together! Although we know not what the year will bring, we enter it confidently as sons and daughters of THE most merciful Father, who loves us as we are and will never, ever take His eyes off us or abandon us. With this knowledge, we begin anew every day and walk forward in faith into 2022.

This past week our students commemorated the Feast of the Epiphany with the traditional "marking of our doorways" and Epiphany Blessing. After the blessing, students were given blessed chalk and a prayer to "mark the doorways" of their homes. Recently, visitors to our school asked about the markings that they were seeing above the doorways, and it was fun to explain the meaning as follows: *The Feast of the Epiphany commemorates the visit of the Magi to honor the infant Jesus. We observe this important feast with the time-honored Christian tradition of chalking or marking the doors. In this tradition, blessed chalk is used to write the following (adapted for 2022) above the entrance of doorways: 22 + C + M + B + 22. The letters represent the initials of the Magi who came to visit Jesus in His first home: Caspar, Malchior, and Balthazar; they also abbreviate the Latin phrase, Christus mansionem benedicat: "May Christ bless the house." The "+" signs represent the cross, and the "22" at the beginning and the "22" at the end mark the year. Taken together, this inscription is performed as a prayer asking Christ to bless the home, and those within, throughout the year. The chalking of the doors encourages all who enter to dedicate their life to God. Seeing the symbols over our doors can help to remind us, while passing in and out, that all those who live there belong to Christ. It also serves as a reminder of honorable welcoming the Magi gave to Jesus.*
