As Christians, we have an ancient tradition of praying for the deceased, praying for the repose of their souls. This tradition stretches all the way back to the Old Testament. One primary way this devotion is expressed in our day is

through the offering of Masses for particular intentions (persons). When the priest offers Mass, he prays certain prayers specifically for the intention of that Mass. We are now scheduling Mass intentions through the entire year of 2022. The standard offering for a Mass is \$5 - please note that this is not the selling of a Sacrament, but rather an act of worship. Instead of bringing a calf or a pair of doves to the temple as they did in the ancient times, we can offer a gift to God from our livelihood. If you would like to re-

LIVING LITURGICALLY THROUGH CHRISTMAS

Fun fact: Christmas does not end on December 25th! Wouldn't it be such a bummer to have all of that waiting and build up through Advent only to have Christmas done in a day? How long Christmas lasts is actually up for debate: some say it's done after the Octave (8 days) following Christmas, others say that Epiphany marks the end of the season, and still some say that Christmas doesn't end until the Baptism of the Lord! Personally, I like to wait until February 2 (the Feast of the Presentation of Jesus), because that's when the Vatican takes down their Nativity. (If it's good enough for the Pope, it's good enough for me.)

There are several feast days between now and Epiphany, (January 2 this year) including St. Stephen (December 26), Feast of the Holy Innocents (December 28), Mary the Mother of God (January 1), etc. The overarching theme for these feasts is focusing on others. St. Stephen was a deacon and the first martyr of the Church. He gave his life for his faith in service of others. The Feast of the Holy Innocents remembers the baby boys murdered by King Herod in an attempt to kill Baby Jesus. Mary is a reminder of saying "yes" to God and motherly love to all.

In honor of these feast days, I challenge you to find a way to serve others this week. It could be as simple as buying coffee for someone, or more involved like volunteering at a food bank. Whatever it is, share a kindness with someone and help to share the joy of Christmas with others. <text>
