A MESSAGE FROM FR JIM BERNING



SOLEMNITY OF THE MOST HOLY TRINITY. As St. Augustine was walking along the seashore and reflecting on the Trinity, he saw a young boy digging a hole in the sand. With a bucket, he was pouring ocean water into the new hole in the sand. St. Augustine asked what he was trying to do. "I am going to fill the entire ocean into my hole," said the boy. Augustine replied, "You cannot possibly pour the contents of the vast ocean into your small hole." The boy responded, "And you cannot fit the mystery of the Holy Trinity into your small brain." At this, the boy vanished.

Even St. Patrick's use of the shamrock (also found in the stained glass windows of our parish church) to explain the Trinity could not exhaust that mystery of our faith. Hint: The shamrocks are located in the window of the Franciscan St. Anthony of Padua whose feast day we celebrate on June 13th. Most Holy Trinity, pray for us...

ANNIVERSARY. Today, Sunday, June 12th, I celebrate and give thanks to the Almighty for my 31st Anniversary of Priesthood with all of you. Please pray for me as I pray for all of you. May God Bless you all!

DIOCESAN MINISTRY DAYS 2022. In late 2019, a Pew Study indicated what many had long suspected. Few Catholics, approximately 30 percent, fully believe in the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. This means that approximately 70 percent of Catholics in the United States don't believe in the Real Presence. There is a tremendous need for a revival of Faith!

This week, from June 14-15, are our Diocesan Ministry Days at St. Mary's University in Winona. The focus this year is the National Eucharistic Revival. The Bishops of the United States are calling for a three-year grassroots revival of devotion and belief in the Real Presence of Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist. They believe that God wants to see a movement of Catholics across the United States, healed, converted, formed, and unified by an encounter with Jesus in the Eucharist - and sent out in mission "for the life of the world." I can give witness to the fact that there is a resurgence of people coming and returning to the Catholic Faith. This is energizing and I am very hopeful for our Church. I look forward to these exciting days with others from our parish and from across the Diocese of Winona-Rochester.

HOY CELEBRAMOS LA SOLEMNIDAD DE LA SANTÍSIMA TRINIDAD, el misterio del amor de Dios.

La Santísima Trinidad, el Padre, el Hijo y el Espíritu Santo, tres personas un solo Dios verdadero, es la solemnidad litúrgica que la Iglesia Universal celebra hoy.

El Papa Francisco en 2013 al explicar a unos niños las tres personas de la Santísima Trinidad les dijo que "el Padre crea el mundo, Jesús nos salva y el Espíritu Santo qué hace? Nos ama, nos da el amor".

El misterio de la Trinidad no se puede entender precisamente porque es un misterio, Santa Juana de Arco afirmaba que "Dios es tan grande que supera nuestra ciencia", por tanto, supera el entendimiento humano. En una oportunidad San Agustín caminaba por la playa cuando observó a un niño que hacía un hoyo en la arena, y el santo le preguntó qué intentaba hacer, el niño le dijo que pensaba meter toda el agua del mar en ese hoyo.

San Agustín, admirado, le dijo: "pero ¿no te das cuenta que es imposible?!", el niño le contestó que "es más posible meter toda el agua del mar en este agujero que intentar meter el misterio de la Trinidad en tu cabeza".

El santo irlandés, San Patricio, para explicar este misterio lo comparaba con una hoja de trébol. Decía que cada hoja es diferente, pero las tres forman el trébol, y que lo mismo pasa con Dios donde cada persona es Dios y forman la Santísima Trinidad.

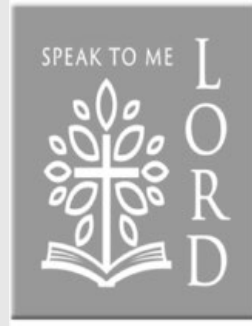
FAMILY CONNECTION.

Think of the last time you witnessed an act of selfless love in your family. Parents and caregivers of all kinds are called upon to act selflessly every day. Family life calls us to share selfless love with one another.

God is the model for us of selfless love. There was no need for God to create our planet or the creatures that inhabit it; it was an act of selfless love. There was also no need for God to send his only Son to save us. That too was an act of selfless love.

As we draw closer to God and the mystery of the Trinity, we learn about God's love. God has lavished us with love in the persons of the Son and the Spirit, who in turn nurture in us the desire to do the same. When we open ourselves to be filled with an awareness of the divine life within us, we participate in the endless spiral of love that leads to eternal life. Whenever we share selfless love in the family, we are sharing in the life of the Trinity.

This week we return to the liturgical season of Ordinary Time. This Sunday and next Sunday, however, are designated as solemnities, special days that call our attention to central mysteries of our faith. Today, on the first Sunday after Pentecost, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. This feast invites us to consider what we believe about God, who has revealed himself to us in the Trinity - one God in three persons.

The verses of today's Gospel come near the end of Jesus' long discourse at the Last Supper. In the early part of this discourse, as we saw last week on Pentecost, Jesus offers assurances to the disciples. Even though he must leave the disciples, he tells them that they will have a future because of the help he will send them in the Holy Spirit. In this section he focuses more on the shape of the future, which will include Jesus' victory over the world that they will share in. The disciples of Jesus cannot know the future. They can only know that, whatever shape the future takes, they will not have to face it alone. They have the Spirit of Truth, who will continue to provide the teaching of Jesus in the future.

Reading this passage on Trinity Sunday reinforces our understanding of the unity shared by the members of the Trinity. Although the idea of one God in three persons remains a mystery, we have the assurance that, as Jesus and the Father share all, Jesus and the Spirit share all.

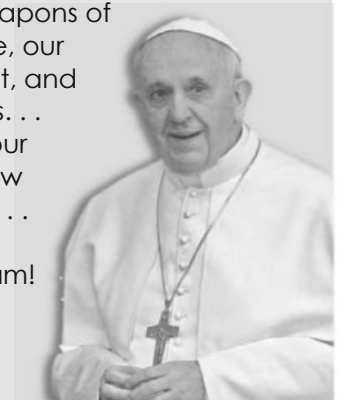
