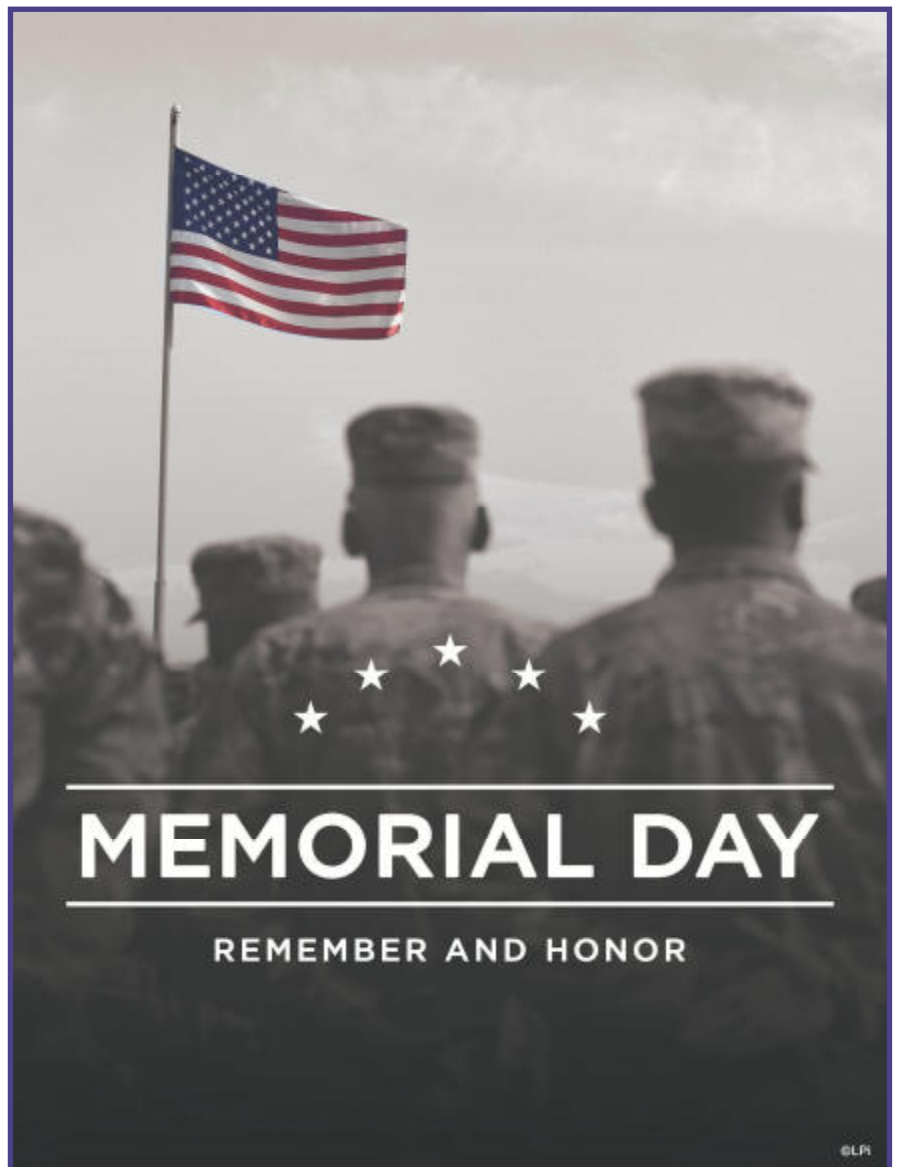

**On Monday, May 31, our nation celebrates Memorial Day**, which commemorates all men and women who have died in military service for the United States. Many people visit cemeteries and memorials on Memorial Day to honor those who have died for our country. People also visit the graves of their family members and friends. Here is a prayer you might like to use when visiting a cemetery. These prayers may be spoken quietly to oneself or aloud with a group.

### **Prayer When Visiting a Cemetery**

In the name of + the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen. Praise be to God our Father, who raised Jesus Christ from the dead. Blessed be God for ever.

My dear friends, we gather today to pray for our brothers and sisters whose bodies lie here in rest. They have passed from death to life in company with the Lord Jesus, who died and rose to new life, and they are purified now of their faults. We pray that God may welcome them among all the saints of heaven.

“Jesus said to his disciples: ‘Do not let your hearts be troubled. You have faith in God; have faith also in me. In my Father’s house, there are many dwelling places. If there were not, would I have told you that I am going to prepare a place for you? And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come back again and take you to myself, so that where I am you also may be. Where I am going you know the way.’ Thomas said to him, ‘Master, we do not know where you are going; how can we know the way?’ Jesus said to him, ‘I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.’” (John 14:1-6)

### **Helping Those Who Are Hungry**

St. Pascal's has had a long-time relationship with Progressive Baptist Church located on Burns Avenue, including Progressive's food pantry. Anyone regardless of denomination is welcome to receive food from its pantry in keeping with the Gospel directive to feed the hungry. If you know of anyone who could use food, please let them know that food distribution is every Saturday morning 10:30 AM - noon. Boxes include canned and dry goods, meat, and fresh produce.

A dedicated group of St. Pascal's parishioners meets each Friday morning at Progressive to help sort and box the food for distribution. Additional help is now needed on the first and third Saturday of each month from 9:00 AM-Noon, beginning June 5 & 19. Volunteers help set up the Saturday distribution, greet those coming to receive food, and return any unused food to its proper storage.
