FEAST OF THE HOLY FAMILY OF JESUS, MARY, AND JOSEPH

There is no better time than the Feast of the Holy Family to recall and to take to heart the exhortation of St. John Paul II: "Family, become what you are!"

As if there were not enough threats to families in the surrounding culture, the pandemic has brought its own suffering. We have heard accounts of people—not just the elderly—being isolated from their families and deprived of the support and comfort of loved ones when it was needed most. Many have died in isolation.

Families are foregoing coming together to celebrate major holidays and anniversaries. Some families have experienced division over opposing convictions about vaccinating and masking. St. John Paul II's exhortation to families to live out their vocation of love, life, and education is as timely today as it was in 1981. If parents and children do not experience "love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, generosity, faithfulness,

gentleness, self-control" (Galatians 5:22–23), as well as forgiveness and reconciliation, in the family, then where will they experience them?

It is vital that husbands and wives renew their awareness that marriage is a vocation from God, and that He entrusts to them a mission of the greatest importance: to bear witness to the bond of love between Christ and the Church by their fidelity to one another, their generosity in fulfilling God's first mandate, which the Bible calls a blessing—"God blessed them. And God said to them, 'Be fruitful and multiply and fill the earth" (Gen 1:28)—and by educating their children in the full truth about God and about His plan for all people He has made in His own image and redeemed in Jesus Christ.

Years ago, someone I had met in graduate school, in Europe, was traveling around the United States. When she came to Minnesota, I arranged for several dinners with friends. When we left after one of those evenings, she turned to me and said, with amazement and joy, "There was so much love in that family!" She observed parents and children working together to make their guest feel welcome, to be attentive to her comfort, to prepare the meal, and to take in interest in her by asking questions about life in Columbia. She observed the courteous and respectful conversation between parents and children. She was deeply moved by being invited to pray with them and the way that this prayer as a family made everyone aware of God's presence.

These days, many often ask, "Where is God?" Or, they challenge, "Prove that God exists." Well, one place where you can find God and one proof of His existence is in the bond of love in a Christian family. For, as the culture around us becomes more and more anti-family, more and more violent, and as true, generous love seems a rare experience, the unity, mutual respect, mutual service, and love in a Christian family stands out all the more clearly as a genuine miracle. And, Christian families will be the first to tell you, when asked how they have become little communities of peace and joy, fidelity and kindness, patience and generosity, that these are all a gift of grace. It is not that there are smarter than others. It is that they are humbler than others and have turned to God as their inspiration and strength.

Holy families are humble families, who are familiar with the struggle to live up to their vocation. That is why holy families make time to pray together, to deepen their faith together, and to attend Mass together. For them, weekly Mass is like a mini pilgrimage, imitating the Holy Family in their annual pilgrimages to Jerusalem. Putting God first is the best way for families to become what they are called to be. For, families who see their lives as a vocation know that the only realistic hope to be faithful to their vocation is the power of God's love and grace. They know that they will need His forgiveness when they fall short of His vision for the family, and when they need to forgive one another as He forgives them. Families where forgiveness and reconciliation are a way of life give hope to others who suffer from broken relationships. Our world is in great need of such hope!

Truly, to experience Christian families of humility and love and forgiveness and reconciliation is to experience the power of the grace of our God. It is to proclaim in action that the birth of Christ has changed the world, that mercy and forgiveness are stronger than the sin that breaks relationships. To experience this is to be convinced that indeed God hears our prayers when we beseech Him: "Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven." This is the vocation of the Christian family: to bear witness to the beauty and joy of heaven on earth, and in this way to be an answer to those who wonder if God exists and where they can find Him!




