



FROM THE PASTOR

Choosing Godparents & Remembering Their Important Role



This weekend we are celebrating the Baptism of the Lord and the official end of the Christmas season. The icon of the Baptism in the back of church and the baptismal font are great places to pause and reflect on the gifts received in this great sacrament.

One of the important factors in preparing for a baptism is choosing Godparents. This is an honor but it is not an *honorary job!* Being a Godparent requires a life lived striving for holiness so as to give an outstanding example to encourage the newly baptized to be a faithful disciple of Jesus.

Here are some practical points in choosing Godparents:

1. There should be one God Mother and one God Father. Sometimes a person may have 3 sisters and ask if each one can be a God mother. This is not possible as there is just one role for God father and God mother. The Godparent should also be at least 16 years old. The Godparent cannot already be the parent of the child

2. At least one Godparent should be a confirmed, practicing Catholic. It is possible in families of mixed religion to have one God parent who is Catholic and the other Godparent who may be Lutheran and serves as a what is called a Christian witness..

3. The Godparents should be people who strive to lead an exemplary life of faith and are supportive of the teachings of our Catholic faith. The role of the God Father and God Mother is to help raise the child to an active life in the Catholic Church. It is best that the Godparent show an example of the Catholic faith through their daily lives as that can have the best support for the child growing in his or her faith.

The important work of Godparents

Here are a few ways that we can support and encourage our Godchildren:

1) **Pray for your Godchildren.** We should pray for our Godchildren each day that they can grow closer to Jesus and stay near to the sacraments. We might also consider making a Holy Hour in the Adoration chapel for our Godchildren. Imagine how wonderful it is for our Godchildren to receive a card saying we offered a holy hour for them.

2) **Be a joyful example in living our lives for Jesus.** Sometimes we may have Godchildren who have slipped away from the practice of the faith. The joyful example of a faithful Catholic Godparent can have a powerful impact over time. Being preachy or arguing with someone rarely brings benefit. Some will be converted by the example and witness of joy in living the Catholic faith. We also need to make sure we are witnessing our faith with joy and love.

3) **Keep in touch.** As Godparents we need to keep close to our Godchildren through occasional letters, phone calls or visits. Sometimes we may have lost touch over the years. This Feast of the Baptism of the Lord presents a great opportunity to reach out and tell our Godchildren that in light of this feast we are thinking of them and praying for them.

4) **Meet for Mass.** If we are geographically close to our Godchildren it might be beneficial to ask them to join us for Mass and a meal---maybe around the anniversary of their baptism or other special feast.


