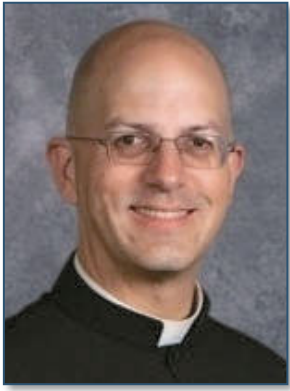

Congratulations to Don and Cathy Wagner



I offer my congratulations to Don and Cathy Wagner as they receive the St. John Paul II Champions for Life award from the Archdiocese. The Wagners will receive this award from the Archbishop on Saturday, January 22, at 10:30am, during the Prayer Service for Life at the Cathedral of St. Paul.

Don and Cathy have distinguished themselves as leaders in our community helping all of us to support life in so many ways. They've helped coordinate the Neighbors Food Drive a few times each year. The project helps to provide food and monetary resources to those in need through Neighbors, Inc. in South St. Paul. This local food shelf serves residents throughout Northern Dakota County. For the past few years, the Wagners have spearheaded our Advent Giving Tree, a collection of Christmas gifts for nearly 50 families receiving assistance through Guiding Star-Wakota Life Care Center. This is a very large project involving countless hours of organization with a major impact on many families in our community.

The Wagners have organized the St. Joseph-sponsored day of prayer with 40 Days for Life in the fall and spring each year at Planned Parenthood, praying for an end to abortion and for those contemplating abortion. They have also been instrumental in supporting other life affirming efforts in the parish and school, including October layette and infant collection, Baby Cakes for Life, Second Stork and Mother's Day flower sale.

My congratulations to Don and Cathy and we celebrate the significant contribution in their witness and service, helping all of us to practice the works of mercy in loving God and our neighbor. Their work has allowed us to participate in building a culture of life here at St. Joseph's—a legacy of love and generosity that our parish family embraces.

I know the Wagners to be people of deep prayer and faith. Their love for Jesus Christ helps them (and our whole parish) to love Jesus in those who are most in need. We can all be inspired by their response to God's tremendous love.

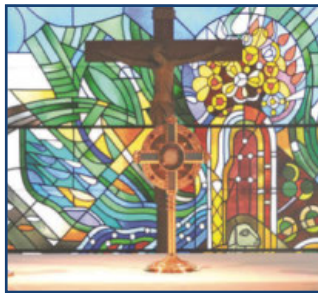
