August 14: Feast Day of St. Maximilian Kolbe, a priest who had a special commitment to the Blessed Virgin Mary, starting at the young age of 10, following her apparition to him. He committed himself to her for the rest of his life. He died in the Nazi Auschwitz concentration camp when he gave his life in place of another man who was selected for a death sentence.
