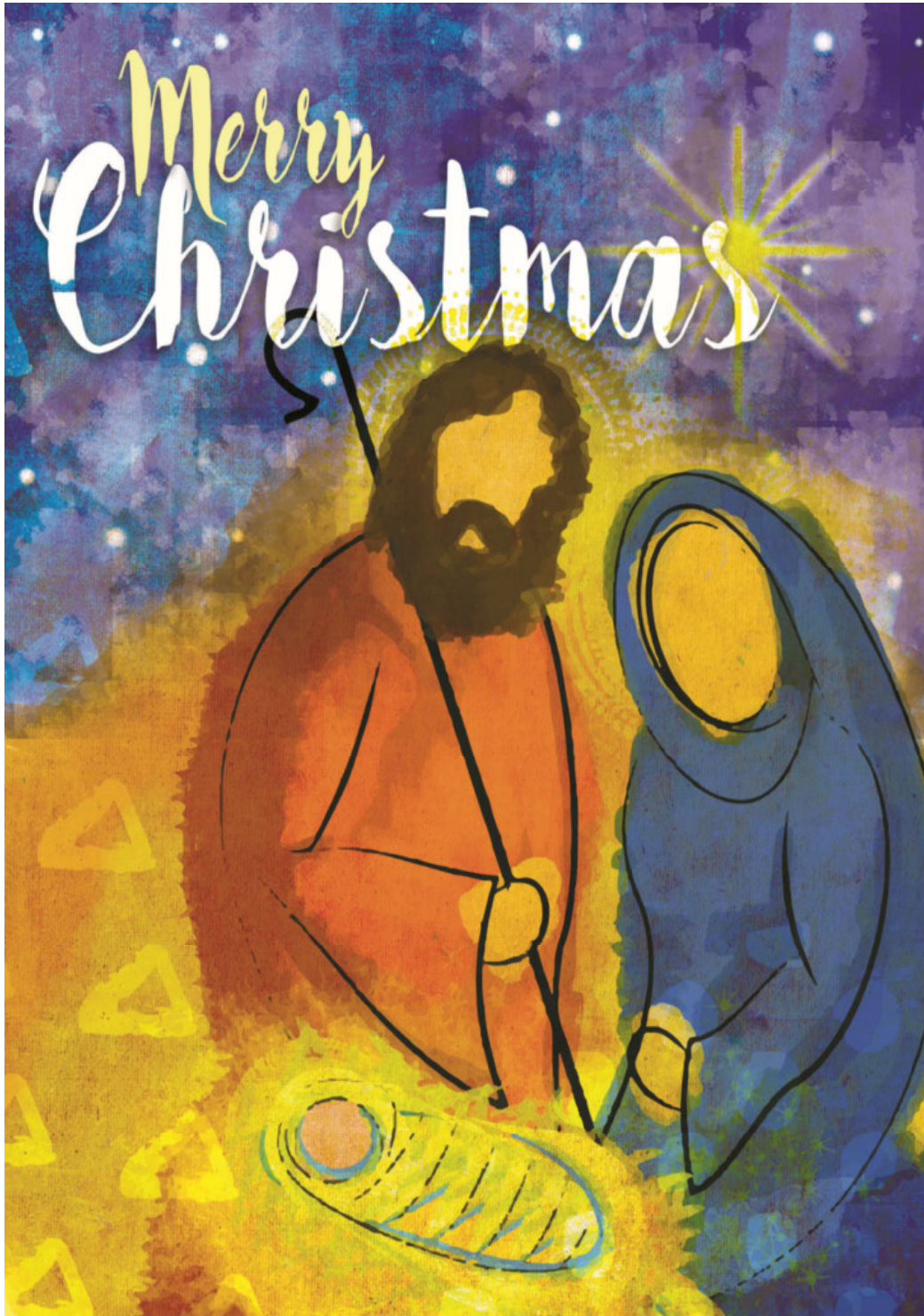

Join this weekly class that aims to help caregivers take better care of themselves while caring for others.

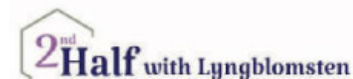

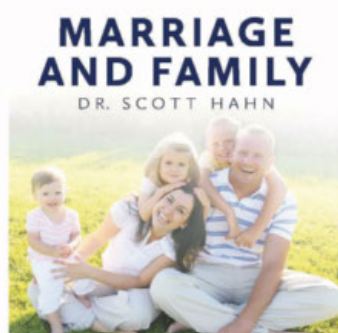

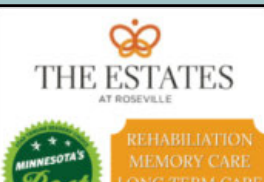
