

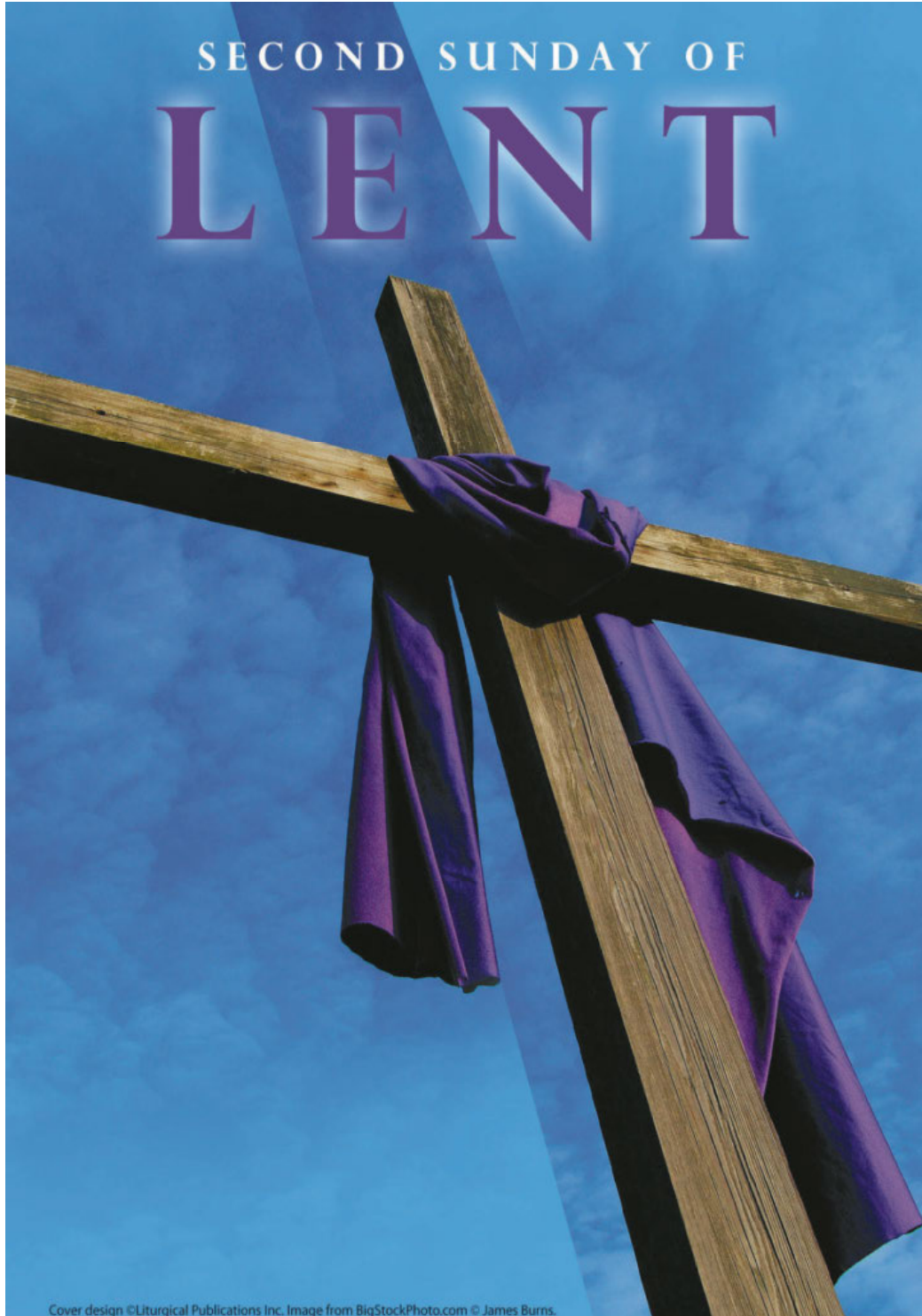

Anointing of the Sick

Anointing of the Sick is the sacrament that is received by those who are seriously ill or suffering. We encourage those whose health is seriously impaired by sickness or old age to attend the Anointing Service. By the sacred anointing and the prayer of the priest, the whole Church commends those who are sick to Christ. The sick person receives the Holy Spirit's gifts of strength, faith, peace, and courage.

St. Odilia will offer a communal Anointing of the Sick in the chapel on:

- **Saturday, March 19 at 6:00pm (following 5:00 pm Mass)**
- **Sunday, March 20 at 10:00am (following 9:00 am Mass)**

It is encouraged that the Sacrament of the Sick should be celebrated as soon as it would be helpful. If the condition of the individual worsens, and the individual reaches the final time before death, they may not be able to fully participate/appreciate what would be happening in the sacrament.

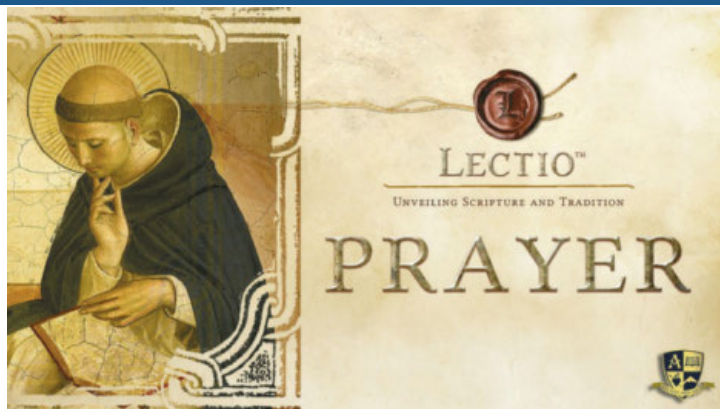

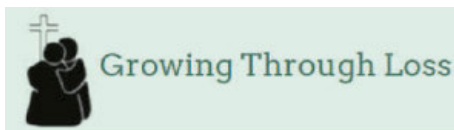

Parishioners donate an average of 200+ pounds of food each week, which is delivered to either the Ralph Reeder Food Shelf or the Franciscan Brothers of Peace. These organizations serve low income, food insecure children, adults and seniors in the Mounds View Public School District and in St. Paul around St. Columba.

For every dollar donated, food shelves can purchase up to 8 pounds worth of food allowing us to “stretch your dollars” even further. In addition to “in kind” food donations, over \$35,000.00 has been donated to these food shelves in the last year. Contributions not only support food shelves but also help educate others about hunger in the community.
