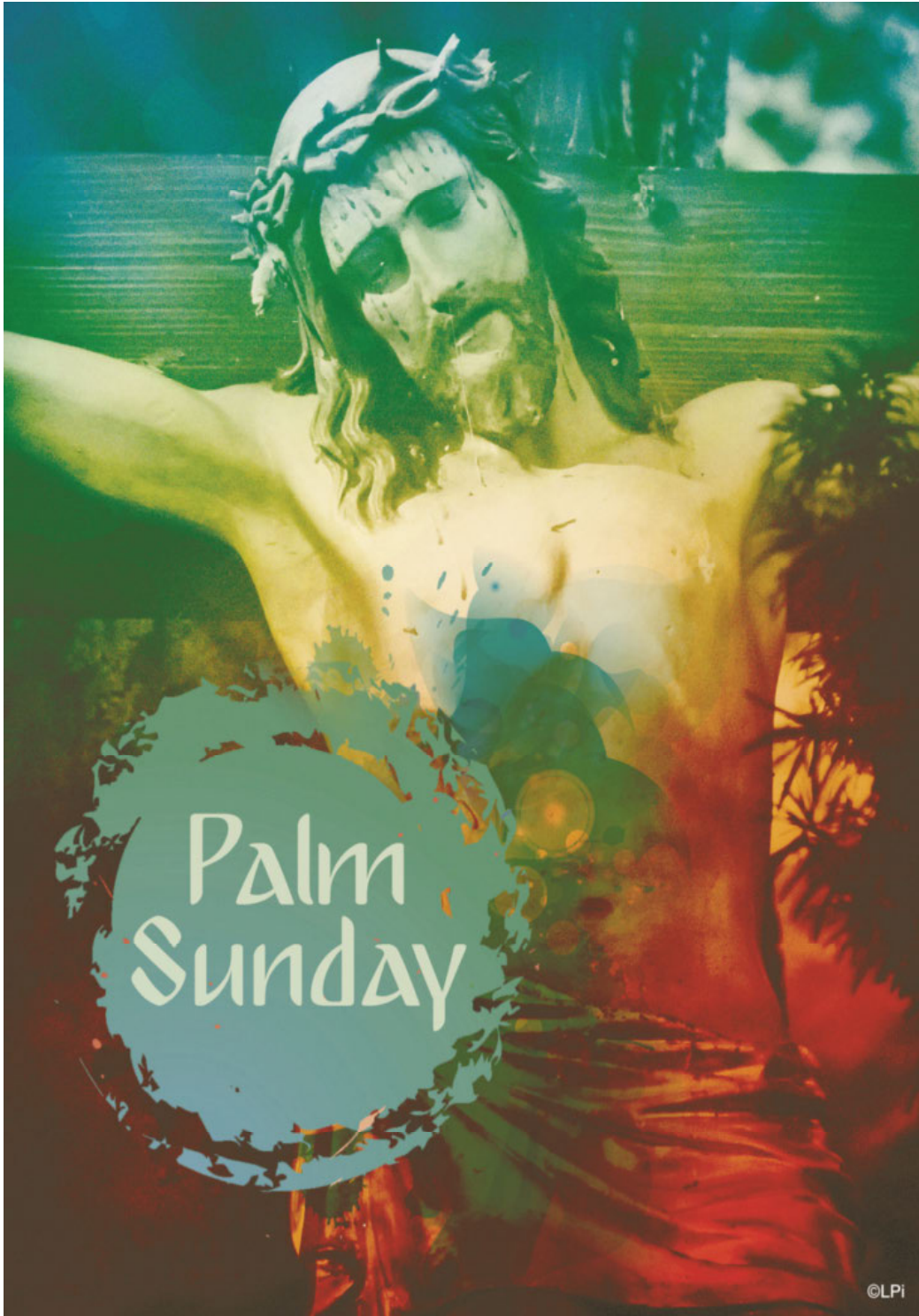

Easter Church & Gym Decorating



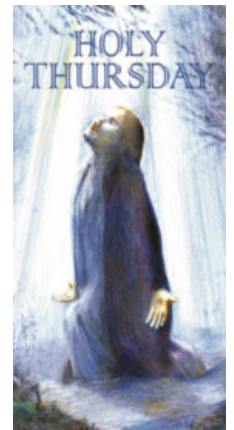

Social Justice Corner

The Lenten Season Reflection and Reconciliation Series, Part 2

This week we continue our Lenten reflection on Catholic Social Teaching. The current Social Justice Council program Faith and Racial Justice focuses on the theme **Call to Family, Community, and Participation**.

This theme is summarized on the USCCB website as, *“The person is not only sacred but also social. How we organize our society—in economics and politics, in law and policy—directly affects human dignity and the capacity of individuals to grow in community. Marriage and the family are the central social institutions that must be supported and strengthened, not undermined. We believe people have a right and a duty to participate in society, seeking together the common good and well-being of all, especially the poor and vulnerable.”*

Take a moment to reflect on this quote from the U.S. Bishop’s 2018 Pastoral Letter, **Open Wide Our Hearts:** *“The poverty experienced by many . . . communities has its roots in racist policies that continue to impede the ability of people to find affordable housing, meaningful work, adequate education, and social mobility.”*

CAMP INVENTION AT ST ODILIA: JUMP INTO BIG ADVENTURES

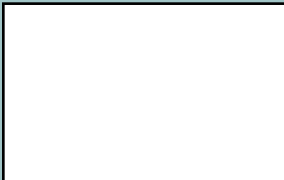
