## AARP Safe Driving Refresher Course

The St. Odilia Knights of Columbus Council 9598 is sponsoring the 4 hour AARP Safe Driving Refresher Course. The class will be conducted in the School Cafeteria beginning at **8:00 am on Saturday May 21, 2022.** The cost is **\$20 for AARP members and \$25 for non-members.** Class size is limited and registration is required.

**Members of the Knights of Columbus will be in the Courtyard taking registrations after Mass this weekend, May 7 & 8 and next weekend, May 14 & 15.** AARP is resuming classes given the CDC's current community Covid risk assessment of 'low'. Participants will not need to be social distanced and wearing masks is optional. However, if the risk level increases the class will be cancelled and paid fees refunded. Also, if anyone develops Covid within 14 days of the class we must notify AARP. A contact person will be identified to participants for this purpose.

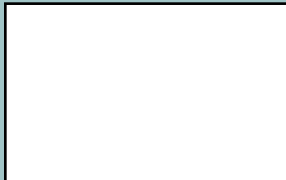
