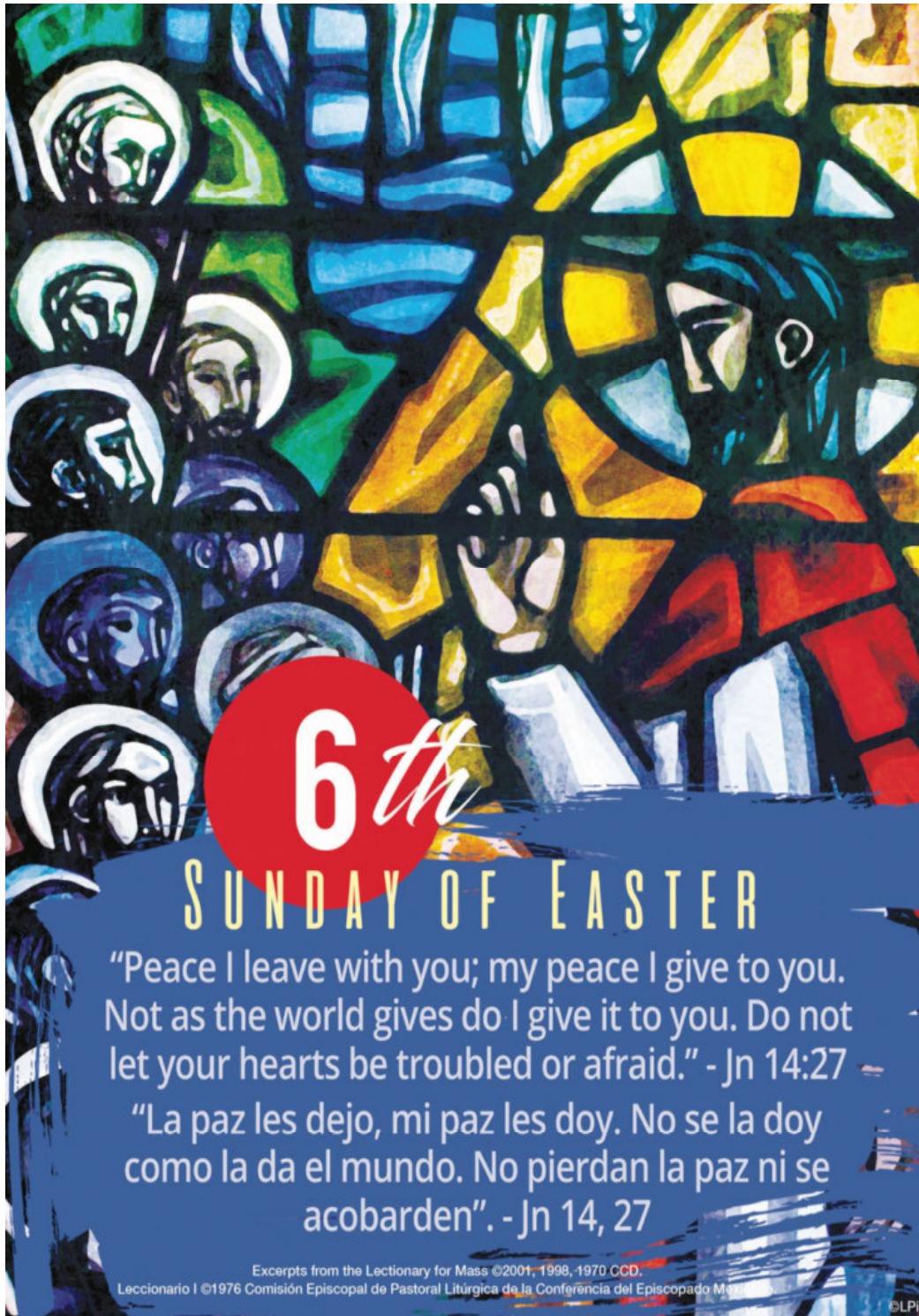

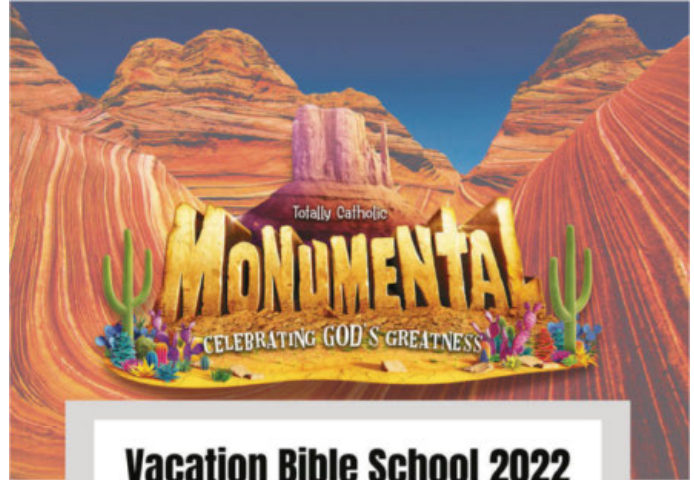

“Jesús promete a los Apóstoles el don del Espíritu Santo, cuya tarea será enseñar y recordar sus palabras a la comunidad de discípulos. Enseñar y recordar: esto es lo que hace el Espíritu Santo en nuestros corazones” (Papa Francisco). Es muy cierto y se tiene la experiencia, de que, la persona que se abandona al Espíritu Santo, da muchos frutos de continua enseñanza y de obras buenas que el Espíritu de Dios hace en ella. Los santos y santas lo han experimentado en sus vidas, mostrando su fe con hechos. El amor de Dios nunca se cansa, si está presente, suceden cosas maravillosas.

“El que ama verdaderamente a Dios, observa sus mandamientos y Dios entra en su corazón y ahí permanece, porque el amor de Dios llena de tal manera su corazón, que al tiempo que le da tentación, no vuelve a su vida pasada” (San Gregorio Magno (540-640) Homilía 30). El reto, en este Sexto Domingo de Pascua, es que continuemos abriendo nuestro corazón y mente a la paz y al amor del Señor. Que no haya en ustedes angustia ni miedo” (Juan 14:27). Oh, bien. “Si alguien me ama, guardará mis palabras” (Juan 14:23). “Que todos sean uno, como tú, Padre, estás en mí y yo en ti” (Juan 17:21). Qué gran alegría la oración sacerdotal de Jesús en este VII Domingo de Pascua. Nos encomienda al Padre y nos revela su amor, por medio de la unidad y la promesa de la gloria que se nos ha dado gracias a su resurrección. Jesús nos amó hasta el extremo y el Padre nos ama igual. Es una oración que llena de esperanza al creyente, para no abandonar la fe y la nueva vida prometida. Jesús pide por todos, para ser protegidos ante el peligro de separarse de la fe. La finalidad es permanecer unidos mutuamente.

El Papa Francisco, en su catequesis sobre la oración Sacerdotal, nos ayuda a reflexionar en un punto muy importante: “Esto me parece lo más bonito para recordar. Esta es la última catequesis de este ciclo dedicada al tema de la oración. Recordar la gracia de que nosotros no solamente rezamos, sino que, por así decir, hemos sido “rezados”, ya somos acogidos en el diálogo de Jesús con el Padre, en la comunión del Espíritu Santo. Jesús reza por mí. Cada uno de nosotros puede colocar esto dentro del corazón, no lo olviden, también en los momentos más difíciles”. Dijo el Santo Padre: “El Apóstol San Juan en el libro del Apocalipsis lo expone de la siguiente manera: “¡Ven! Que el que escucha diga también: ¡Ven! El que tenga sed, que se acerque y el que lo desee, reciba gratuitamente el agua de la vida”” (Apocalipsis 22:17). ¿Cómo es tu fe y tu oración? ¿Sientes que respondes a Jesús, en su petición al Padre, de permanecer unidos en el amor? ©LPi

WORDS MATTER



When you hear the word “volunteer” what do you think of? When you hear the word “disciple” what do you think of? Being a volunteer is a good start however, becoming a disciple is the next step on the path of holiness.

Unknowingly, many of us are operating at the “volunteer” level and not at the “disciple” level. When we volunteer, we usually do it when it is convenient for us. When we disciple, it’s according to God’s timeline. His plan, not ours. Discipleship recognizes that time is a gift from God. All of time is His. By using time according to God’s plan, that becomes our gift back to God.

Do you want to grow as a disciple? Then let’s change the words we use to help change our perspective.

- Volunteer implies giving some of our time. Disciple implies a way of life. It’s not something that we do, it’s how we live.
- Volunteer brings a little pride and ego into the picture. Disciple is based in humility, becoming more God-centered and other-centered, and less self-centered.
- Volunteer sometimes puts the focus on ourselves; “Look what I did!” Disciple puts others’ needs first. It puts the focus on Jesus.
- Volunteer is usually temporary happiness. Happy when you do it, but then the feeling fades. Disciple usually grows in inner peace and joy, regardless of the circumstances.
- Volunteer implies we make a choice to participate or not. Disciple implies we have already made the choice. We choose God.

Something to keep in mind as we move from volunteer to disciple.
