## *BEFORE I FORGET*



Lt. Richard Zimmerman is the longest-serving officer in the Minneapolis Police Department. A 36-year veteran of the force, he heads the Minneapolis homicide unit. Lt. Zimmerman testified on the fifth day of the trial of former Minneapolis police officer Derek Chauvin in the death of George Floyd.

In his testimony, Lt. Zimmerman explained that when a police officer handcuffs someone, “that person is yours. He’s your responsibility. His safety is your responsibility, his wellbeing, and he is your responsibility.”

All police officers are trained, Lt. Zimmerman said, that once an officer can restrain the person, making them less combative, “you may just have them sit down on the curb...the idea is to calm the person down. If they are not a threat to you at this point, you try to help them, so that they’re not as upset as they many have been in the beginning.”

“THAT PERSON IS YOURS.” That basic principle was at the heart of the early Christian community we read about in the Acts of the Apostles. To care for one another in the spirit of Jesus’ Gospel led Peter and the Jerusalem Christian community to “lay hands” on seven individuals who were to become the Church’s first “deacons” – from the Greek word *diakonos*, meaning “servant.”

Every one of us is called by our baptism to the role of *diakonos*, of taking seriously our responsibility, for the care and safety of one another, regardless of our nationality, race or gender. In baptism, we commit ourselves to live the Gospel Jesus taught by imitating his service to the poor, the needy, the suffering, the lost. In Christ, “every person is yours.”

Today, tomorrow, every day, you can be *diakonos* – *diakonos* to a family member, a friend, a sales clerk, a wait staff, someone you meet while waiting in a checkout line. For the care and safety of everyone is our responsibility as followers of Jesus, as decent human beings; the neediest and most vulnerable among us is “OURS.”
