



A Message From Fr. John

As we bring our homily series titled "Breakfast with a Saint" to a close, we look at one last aspect of Saint Mother Teresa's life. During her life Mother Teresa devoted herself to those living in the shadows and dark corners of life: the poor, the dying, the abandoned, the unwanted. That was the figure that captured the world's imagination and the world's heart. Yet she always spoke of the deeper poverty of the spirit, the poverty that comes from not knowing God, and living far from Him.

After her death it was revealed that Mother Teresa's spiritual life was primarily marked by darkness and suffering. For over fifty years her prayer life was characterized by experiences of the absence of God. Among great Saints, she is not alone. It is what St. John of the Cross called the "dark night of the soul." It does not mean that the world is bleak outside, but rather that the soul itself feels the lack of the Lord's light. Her patron saints, the "Little Flower," St. Therese of Lisieux, and the great mystic and doctor of the Church, St. Teresa of Avila also experienced the dark night, in which God seemed more absent than present. Mother Teresa herself wrote, "If I ever become a saint, I will surely be one of 'darkness'."

She confided in Archbishop Périer of Calcutta: "In my soul I feel just that terrible pain of loss, of God not wanting me, of God not being God, of God not really existing." She saw it as a way of completely identifying with Christ, even in his feelings of abandonment on the Cross.

This Sunday we celebrate the baptism of the Lord and bring the Christmas season to an end. We often think of baptism as life giving. But baptism represents death and new life. Pope Benedict, writing before he became Pope about Christ's baptism, reminded readers that Jesus loaded the burden of all of humanity's guilt upon his shoulders: "He inaugurated his public activity by stepping into the place of sinners. His inaugural gesture is an anticipation of the Cross. He is, as it were, the true Jonah who said to the crew of the ship, "Take me and throw me into the sea" (Jon. 1:12).

Mother Teresa felt similarly, writing "The place of God in me is blank - there is no God in me." But despite this darkness, she never gave up longing for Him, writing, "I just long & long for God." Mother Teresa had a tremendous mystical experience earlier in her life. No doubt part of the darkness she felt was she anticipated she would have similar events over and over again, which never recurred. But for anyone living in darkness physically or spiritually, her example, love, and now intercession from heaven is a bright light.







This winter we will return to what has been our policy concerning weekday Mass and Exposition of the Eucharist for Adoration. We follow the closings of the Hudson School District which is announced/posted on the local news networks.

School is closed for the day | The weekday Mass will be canceled, the Eucharist will not be exposed, and our building will be considered closed for the entire day.

School is closed for the day on Wednesday | All evening programs for our youth are cancelled.

School is a late start | The weekday Mass will be canceled, the Eucharist will not be exposed until noon, and our building will not open until 10:00 AM.

School closes early | Exposition of the Eucharist will end at 5:00 PM, and all youth and adult activities will be cancelled.

School closes early on a Wednesday | All evening youth programs will be canceled as well as any Parish activities.

Weekend and Holy Day Masses will always be as scheduled.

This policy is to help keep you and our staff safe while allowing for our contractors to safely and effectively clear our parking lot and sidewalks.
