## FALL UPDATES AT NATIVITY

Nativity of Mary is currently open on weekdays from 6:30am-4:30pm for private prayer as well as posted Confession, Adoration, and Mass Times. All Masses are celebrated at their usual times.

As of July 1, the bishops of Minnesota have reinstated the Obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation, and we are overjoyed to welcome everyone back to Mass! The return of our faith family to Mass is a joyous occasion! Although the general dispensation will no longer be available, the Church has always recognized that certain circumstances can excuse a person from the requirement to observe the obligation. Due to the important connection between the celebration of the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass and reception of the Eucharist, drive-through Communion is no longer offered at Nativity. If you are not able to return to church but would still like to receive the Eucharist, please contact the Parish Office to find out more about our homebound eucharistic ministry.

**Facemasks:** Those fully vaccinated are not at significant risk for contracting or spreading the coronavirus don't need to wear facemasks. Individuals who are more comfortable wearing a facemask may continue doing so but we will no longer require masks in the church buildings. Additionally, masks are strongly recommended in Nativity of Mary School.

**Social Distancing:** There are no longer any distancing or capacity restrictions in place in the church buildings. For those who prefer more social distancing, the Gathering Space and Chapel areas continue to be available.

**Ongoing General Safety Protocols:** If you are sick, stay at home. Please take care of yourself and protect others from becoming infected. Vulnerable persons and those caring for them should stay safe. Attend nonobligatory gatherings only to the extent that you judge the risk of infection to be low. Do what you are comfortable doing. An individual may always practice more restrictive facemask and social distance standards than are required. Sanitization is effective. Washing hands and using hand sanitizer helps avoid both contracting and spreading infection. Vaccines are still recommended.

2. **Cornerstone** helps women and their children in the southwest suburbs escape physical abuse, rebuild shattered lives and increase self-esteem. This ministry has adapted due to COVID-19 and is seeking warm winter wear, as well as gift cards for the families they serve to be able to get needed supplies as well as Christmas gifts for each other. Cornerstone cannot accept any gifts with violent themes such as toy weapons or action figures, so please keep that in mind if selecting an item with a pattern or popular character print.
3. **Angel Tree Gift Cards—Purchase through SCRIP**  
This year we have an order form you can pick up near the bulletins or print out from our website to purchase your Angel Tree Gift Cards through SCRIP. This helps someone in need, and our school at the same time! You do not need to take an angel off the tree to participate in this way. Simply fill out the form and mail it to the school office with your check. You can also return the form in person to the offertory drop box at the North Entrance. When the cards are delivered to the school the SCRIP coordinators will bring the cards directly to the parish office, along with your order form, so that the ministry you select will benefit.

### SABBATICAL REFLECTIONS

One of my excursions while on Sabbatical in Ireland was to the area of Galway, which is a famous port town on the West of the Isle. Galway is considered one of the most popular cities in Ireland largely because of its beauty and culture. The patron saint of the city of Galway is St. Nicholas of Myra largely because the use of the Ocean access has brought countless sailors into and out of its ports (St. Nick is the Patron saint of sailors as well). The small boat that is in one of the pictures is a recreation of the traditional Irish boat called the Currach. It was used in Ireland for centuries to fish in the bays. The boats are constructed of a simple wooden frame with animal skins stretch over it. Another famous thing that has come from Galway is the Claddagh ring which many Irish people wear to show if they are married or looking for a spouse. The image is a heart with a crown over it in the center, and two arms embracing the heart make up the band of the ring. If an Irish person is "taken" the point of the heart points into their body. If they are looking for a spouse it is pointed outwards (showing that they are looking for love).
