Doubt - a Doorway to Faith

Each year on the Second Sunday of Easter we hear the gospel story about Thomas, one of the Twelve. He is best known as the "doubting Thomas" because he doubts that the risen Christ has appeared to the others in his absence. But for Thomas, doubt becomes a doorway to deeper faith. He is invited to touch the wounds of the body of the Risen Jesus. And he proclaims the now famous words, "My Lord and my God."

There is a tremendously hopeful lesson from this Easter story for us who live in the 21st century of Christianity. We can easily become fearful or ashamed of our own experiences of doubt. It feels uncomfortable.

The Good News is that doubt can lead to greater faith when we acknowledge its reality and when we acknowledge the reality of the Risen Christ who is always with us. Like Thomas, we might find ourselves being led to a long-lasting deeper level of faith that includes a more intimate sense of Christ's presence.

What and who have helped you in times of doubt? How can you help another "doubting Thomas" come to greater faith?

Duda - una Puerta a la Fe

Cada año, en el segundo domingo de Pascua, escuchamos la historia del evangelio acerca de Tomás, uno de los Doce. Él es mejor conocido como el "incrédulo Tomás" porque duda de que el Cristo resucitado se haya aparecido a los demás en su ausencia. Pero para Thomas, la duda se convierte en una puerta a una fe más profunda. Él es invitado a tocar las heridas del cuerpo de Jesús resucitado. Y proclama las ahora las famosas palabras: "Mi Dios y mi Señor".

Hay una lección tremendamente esperanzadora de esta historia de Pascua para nosotros que vivimos en el siglo XXI del cristianismo. Fácilmente podemos volvernos temerosos o avergonzarnos de nuestras propias experiencias de duda. No es nada cómodo.

La Buena Nueva es que la duda nos lleva a una mayor fe cuando entendemos que es una realidad y cuando reconocemos la realidad de Cristo resucitado que siempre está con nosotros. Al igual que Thomas, podríamos encontrarnos yendo a un nivel de fe más profundo y duradero que incluye un sentido más íntimo de la presencia de Cristo.

¿Qué y quién te ha ayudado en tiempos de duda? ¿Cómo puedes ayudar a otro "incrédulo Tomás" a tener más fe?


Grief Coalition Spring Series

SIGNAGE/LETTERING: 'Roman Catholic' vs. 'Catholic Community'

Numerous parishioners approached us regarding the wording on the concrete sign. Currently it displays the 1501 for our address and Church of the Risen Savior - Roman Catholic. The suggestion was brought forth to change the wording to Church of the Risen Savior - Catholic Community instead (i.e. dropping the Roman Catholic, which is a more ecclesiastic verbiage). Catholic Community sounds more open (Risen Savior Mission Statement!) and inviting; the language is more modern. After much consideration and after consulting with the Parish Pastoral Council, Fr. Tom decided to change the wording to *Catholic Community*.

Logistically, this will not be a problem because new lettering for the concrete sign was already in the plan because (1) the electronic message boards will take up more space, hence the existing lettering will require adjusting, and (2) the current letters are deteriorating.

'Thank you' to everyone who came to us with this suggestion. First, there was just one person, then another, and another, and another, and so on. Thank you for your input!



CARE FOR CREATION & EARTH DAY

Over the weeks leading up to Earth Day (April 22), you are invited to pray for, learn about, and take action to care for creation. This week's focus is on simplicity and countering the *throwaway culture*.

Pray: Have you ever thought about how what you consume, purchase, and throw away relates to your faith life? Try spending a few minutes holding that question in your heart as you pray the *Prayer for Simplicity: Lighten my load, Lord. Help me to keep in balance the things I desire with those I truly need. May I give generously to those whose needs are far more pressing than my own. Lighten my mind, Lord. Help me to relinquish my opinions and judgments. By widening my worldview, may I come to a greater appreciation of the diversity of your people. Lighten my heart, Lord. Help me to release any toxic emotions that constrict my love and limit my compassion. Let gratitude, kindness, and delight in life arise in me like the sweetest song. In imitation of your devoted servant, St. Francis of Assisi, may I come to embrace simplicity as a sacred way to live. Amen.* [From Sadlier webelieveandshare.com].

Learn: Pope Francis has spoken extensively on how our worldview is one of convenience, where everything is seen as disposable, replaceable or temporary. This impacts how we relate to the earth and one another. As a practical learning piece this week re-think the slogan *Reduce, Reuse, Recycle*. To be an even more mindful steward of creation, consider these updated 6 R's of sustainability: (1) Refuse [single-use items and what you don't need], (2) Reduce [your spending on what you don't actually need; donate goods that you no longer use], (3) Repair [items that can be fixed instead of purchasing new], (4) Reuse [choose reusable products instead of single-use], (5) Recycle [items that can be recycled], (6) Rot [compost organic materials]. Check out our link below for resources to learn more!

Act: When you go to purchase something, big or small, this week, ask yourself if this is a need or want. Is it something that will end up in a landfill? Can you put the 6 R's of sustainability into practice? You might also challenge yourself to pick one type of item you often need, such as personal care items or electronics. Research how you can buy local and buy quality; avoid fast fashion or poor-quality purchases. This will reduce the carbon spent on transporting/producing goods, as well as the need to frequently replace items.

Our Risen Savior *Environmental Concerns Committee* is excited to share that we will celebrate *Earth Day* with an inspiring and educational video about care for creation. It'll include exciting news about our parish butterfly and shade gardens, prayers everyone can do from home, "how-to" tips on creation care, and stories about why creation is close to our committee members' hearts.
