## The Pastor's Corner / Rincón del Párroco



### 2 Kings 4:42-44 / Ephesians 4:1-6 / John 6:1-15

In today's first reading the prophet Elisha feeds 100 people during a time of famine with 20 small barley loaves. That seems rather miraculous until you compare it to Jesus' feeding 5,000 with seven loaves and two fish. Juxtaposing the two events illustrates both the fulfillment and surpassing of the Old Covenant in Jesus Christ and his ministry. It should be noted that the two miracles were preceded by and made possible due to the generosity of people willing to share what they had with others in need.

The Sunday gospel selections during ordinary time of year B are generally a somewhat continuous reading from the gospel of Mark. We switch this Sunday, however, to the account of the multiplication of loaves and fishes from the gospel of John. The major difference between this and the account of the same event in Mark 8:1-8 occurs in who provides the food. In Mark, the apostles themselves have the five loaves and two fish. Here a little boy comes forward to offer Jesus the lunch his family has brought. God invites us to be generous in sharing our material blessings, time and talents for the good of the broader community . . . a catalyst which God can then bless and multiply many times over.

### 2 Kings 4:42-44 / Ephesians 4:1-6 / John 6:1-15

*En la primera lectura de este domingo el profeta Eliseo alimenta a una multitud de 100 personas con 20 panes de cebada. Parece muy milagroso hasta que se compara con la multiplicación que hizo Jesús, dando a comer a 5.000 personas con siete panes y dos pescados. Yuxtaponiendo los dos eventos indica a la vez el cumplimiento y superación del Antiguo Testamento en la persona y ministerio de Jesucristo. Se nota que los dos milagros fueron precedidos y hechos posibles por la generosidad de personas ofreciendo lo que tenían para servir a los demás.*

*Generalmente el evangelio para los domingos del tiempo ordinario del ciclo B está seleccionado en una continuación de lecturas del evangelio de San Marcos. Se cambia este domingo a la cuenta de la multiplicación de panes y pescados del evangelio de San Juan. La diferencia principal entre las dos cuentas de Juan y Marcos 8,1-8 ocurre en la cuestión de quien provee los panes y pescados...en Marcos los apóstoles los tienen y en Juan un niño se acerca para ofrecer lo que su familia había traído a Jesús. Dios nos invita hacernos generosos con los demás con nuestras posesiones materiales, nuestro tiempo y nuestros talentos...a que Dios puede añadir y multiplicarlo por su bendición.*

## More from the pastor . . .

### God's Angels and Saints

Between my first and second stints at St. Paul Seminary (that's another story), a friend and I decided one winter night that we would spend the upcoming summer biking to the east coast and back. We mapped out our route, figuring 100 miles a day should be doable. The fact that neither of us owned a bicycle or had ever ridden anywhere close to that distance in a day didn't faze us. It was decided. When spring arrived, I bought a bike and started training. Returning one day from a 75-mile ride, my farthest until then, I collapsed on my bed totally drained praying for the energy to get up and get a glass of water. How was I ever going to do 100 miles day after day?

I needed a real long ride to test myself. I decided to bike from Prior Lake to Lake Okoboji in Iowa, 165 miles in one day. With some clothes in a pack and \$10 in my pocket, I started out. About 75 miles into my journey, I had spent all my money and was worn out. Reality was beginning to set in. Around 5:30 p.m. I still had 50 miles to go. I was coming down a long hill into Trimont, Minnesota, when a kid on a motorcycle rode out of town, up the hill, turned around and came alongside of me. "Are you hungry?" he asked. "I sure am," I replied. "Follow me." His folks had gone to Mankato and had seen me on their way there and back. Returning home, they had fixed dinner and waited, watching out their kitchen window, for me to come over the top of the hill. Between the delicious pork chop dinner and sandwiches they prepared for the remainder of my journey, I reached my destination around 11:30 p.m. with a full stomach and a grateful heart.

I learned a lot that day. I learned that I could do 100 miles a day. I learned how to plan better for the long ride and how to pace myself. But most of all, I learned, as did the disciples whom Jesus sent out two by two without food or money, to have faith that somehow God will provide through his angels and living saints like that family in Trimont.

Our parishioner support remains strong. The month of June 2021 was a little behind budget. However, for the 12 months ending June 2021 we are on budget. 





# Una nota del pastor Denny:



### Ángeles y santos de Dios

Una noche de invierno entre mis primera y segunda temporadas en el seminario de San Pablo (esa es otra historia) un amigo y yo decidimos pasar el próximo verano corriendo en bicicleta ida y vuelta a la costa oriental. Determinamos una ruta pensando en correr 100 millas cada día. No nos preocupaba que ninguno de los dos de nosotros tenía una bicicleta o había corrido tantas millas en un solo día. Cuando llegó la primavera, compré una bicicleta y empecé a entrenarme. Un día, regresando de un paseo de 75 millas, lo más lejos que había recorrido hasta este punto, caí en mi cama medio muerto sin energía ni para levantarme para tomar un vasito de agua. ¿Cómo podría correr 100 millas día tras día en el viaje?

Necesitaba ponerme a la prueba y determiné correr 165 millas en un solo día de Prior Lake a Lago Okoboji en Iowa. Salí temprano con un poco de ropa en una mochila y \$10 en mi bolsillo. A las 75 millas había gastado todo mi dinero y energía. La realidad de mi situación estaba enfrentándose. Cerca de las 5:30 p.m. todavía me faltaba 50 millas. Acerquándome a Trimont, Minnesota, vi a un joven en su moto salir del pequeño pueblo, subir en la carretera y llegar a mi lado. Mi preguntó, "¿Tiene hambre?" "Claro que sí," le respondí. "Sígame entonces." Sus papás habían pasado por Mankato y me habían visto en su ida y su regreso. Volviendo a casa, prepararon la cena y se pusieron a esperarme, mirando de la ventana en su cocina hacia un poco distante en la carretera. Entre la deliciosa comida de chuletas de cerdo y sándwiches para comer en vía, llegue a mi destino a las 11:30 p.m. con la barriga llena y el corazón bien contento.

Aprendí mucho ese día. Aprendí que podía correr 100 millas al día y como planificar y regular el ritmo de un día así. Pero, sobre todo, aprendí, como los apóstoles que Jesús envió en misión sin comida y dinero, confiar en la divina providencia de Dios por medio de sus ángeles y sus santos vivos como esa familia de Trimont.


