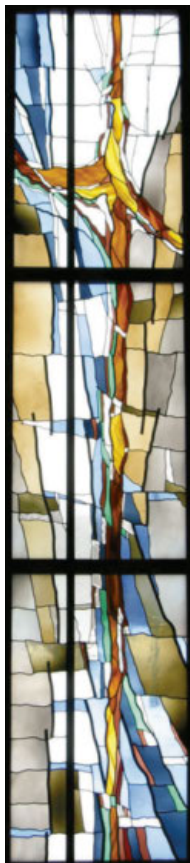

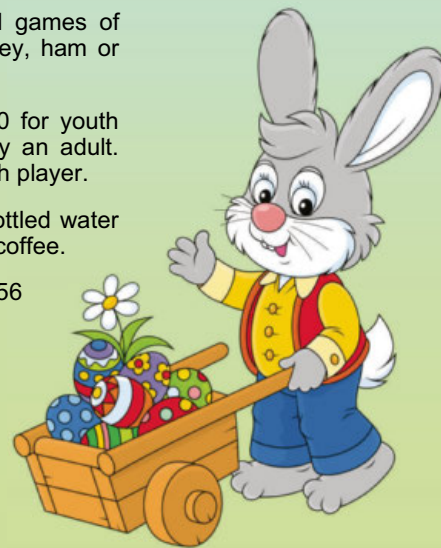

Joyful Celebration of the Rite of Election and Call to Continuing Conversion with R.C.I.A./R.I.C.A.



At the end of February, Risen Savior celebrated the *Rite of Sending* to pray for our RCIA/RICA group as they prepared to enter the next period of their formation. On March 6, our RCIA/RICA group, their sponsors, and family joined other parishes at the *Cathedral of St. Paul* to celebrate the *Rite of Election and Call to Continuing Conversion* with Archbishop Hebda. This rite is significant because the candidates express their desire and intent to be fully initiated into the Church at the *Easter Vigil*, and the Archbishop, on behalf of the whole Church, promises to bestow the sacraments. LENTEN “FOOD FOR THOUGHT”



Lent is a time for us to reflect on our lives in many ways and repent for actions or thoughts that take us further away from God. We can reflect on the abundance of food available to us, and how we waste food without much thought. We can reflect on how all kinds of waste leads to the degradation of the environment and is preventable. We can reflect on our blessings and be mindful of how our lifestyle impacts other humans and our planet.

This Sunday, the Knights of Columbus are sponsoring a pancake breakfast after each Mass. Risen Savior has already taken many steps toward plastic reduction and recycling, especially during events where food is served. For example, we provide compostable single use items (paper towels, napkins, plates, trash bags, hot and cold cups and eating utensils). The kitchen composts food scraps after all events. Risen Savior works with a Dakota County recycling incentive to increase recycling and decrease trash.

So, when you go downstairs for the pancake breakfast, please be mindful of the ways to discard all types of waste, and follow the signs to place all waste in the appropriate containers. Members of the ECC will be available to guide you to the correct receptacles. Do your part by helping to reduce and reclaim waste today.

In his encyclical, *Laudato Si*, Pope Francis inspires us with these words; “Education in environmental responsibility can encourage ways of acting which directly and significantly affect the world around us, such as avoiding the use of plastic and paper, reducing water consumption, separating refuse, cooking only what can reasonably be consumed, showing care for other living beings, using public transport or car-pooling, planting trees, turning off unnecessary lights, or any number of other practices. All of these reflect a generous and worthy creativity which brings out the best in human beings. Reusing something instead of immediately discarding it, when done for the right reasons, can be an act of love which expresses our own dignity.” (#211)

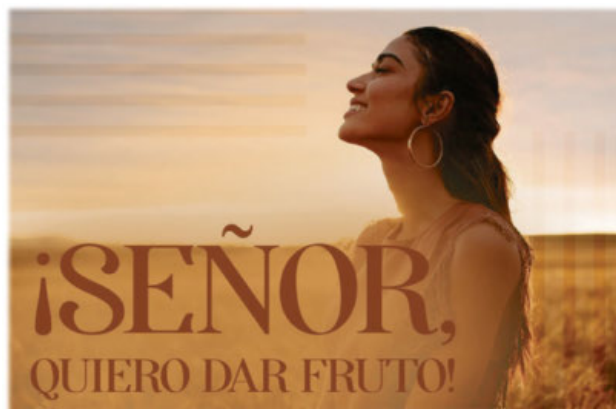

20 de Marzo de 2022 3 Domingo de la Cuaresma



No se puede echar en saco roto la predicación de Jesús, urge la conversión, el Evangelio evoca diversos motivos para el cambio radical de la persona. La gente le pregunta y él responde con claridad y sencillez. San Gregorio Magno (540-604. Homilía 31, 4), exhorta a las personas con una reflexión profunda sobre la higuera que no da fruto: "Con un grande temor se debe escuchar lo que se dice: Córdala. ¿Para qué ocupa la tierra inútilmente? Cada uno a su manera, si no hace buenas obras. Pero desde el momento que ocupa un espacio en la vida presente, es un árbol que ocupa inútilmente el terreno, porque en ese lugar en donde está, impide que ahí se ponga otro a trabajar".

Continua su homilía. "Pero hay algo más grave, y es que los poderosos de este mundo, si no realizan ningún bien, no lo hacen producir ni siquiera en aquellos que dependen de ellos, porque su ejemplo actúa sobre sus subalternos como una sombra estimulante de perversidad... Sofocados por la sombra no reciben el calor del sol y permanecen fríos, sin el calor de Dios. Pero el pensamiento de este poderoso, cualquiera que sea su nombre, no es más objeto directo de los cuidados de Dios. Dejarnos cuidar por Dios es el mensaje de Cristo. La Iglesia administra cuidadosamente los sacramentos para que sus fieles acudan a recibir el abono por medio de ellos. Los sacramentos de iniciación cristiana son la base. Bautismo, Confirmación y Eucaristía. ¿Los frecuentas? ¿Cómo te ayudan a crecer y dar fruto en tu vida?"
