COVID-19 UPDATE FOR RISEN SAVIOR

Starting on April 1, 2022, all COVID-19 restrictions were lifted. The Centers for Disease Control, who continue to track COVID pandemic levels, have reclassified the Twin Cities area with a community level risk of "Low." As a result of this reclassification, as of Friday, April 1, 2022, the Archdiocese of St. Paul and Minneapolis is rescinding all pandemic restrictions for liturgical celebrations. All parishes are now allowed to proceed as they see fit. Here is how this will affect our Risen Savior community:

- Facemasks are no longer required for (liturgical) volunteers or those in the assembly.
- Social distancing is no longer required.
- Shaking hands at the Sign of Peace is permitted.
 - * The faithful are reminded, however, to respect the level of comfort of neighbors who prefer not to touch.
- We will continue to live-stream the Sunday 9:00 a.m. Mass.

Even though these safety protocols are no longer required, it is still each individual's right to continue them on their own. If you feel more comfortable social distancing or wearing a mask, you are welcome to do so.

We are very happy to report these protocol changes. We will continue to follow CDC, MN Department of Health, and the Archdiocesan quidelines as we move forward.

LENTEN "FOOD FOR THOUGHT"



Most of us are aware of the recycling efforts of our communities, and we try to avoid single use plastic items. Did you know that food can also be recycled? One-third of what is being thrown in the trash is food waste and could be composted instead. That's nearly nine pounds per household per week! Instead of trashing it, turn food scraps into rich compost, a soil additive that increases the nutrients in soil, reduces erosion and decreases the need for chemical fertilizers.

In Dakota County, it's free and easy to start composting food waste. Refer to our handouts #5 and #6 (combined into one QR code below) to get started on composting food waste in your household. Or, go to www.dakotacounty.us and search "organics" to get a free kit to start composting food waste at home. In the Commons today, you can play a *Spin the Wheel* game about food waste. There will be prizes! Also, pick up a free container cling to use at home to let everyone in the house know what's compostable and what's not.


