#### **Silent Auction bidding process:**

Each piece of art has a bid sheet displaying the title of the piece, the fair market value, minimum bid increment, and starting bid.

- On Saturday, April 30, bidding closes at 7:45 p.m.
  - Any pieces that have not reached the fair market value by 7:45 p.m. on April 30, will be brought forward to the auction on Sunday, May 1.
  - ♦ All pieces that have reached or surpassed the fair market value, go to the highest bidder at 7:45 p.m. on April 30 and can be paid for and taken home that day.
- On Sunday, May 1, we are offering several bidding periods.
  - ♦ The first bidding period starts at 8:30 a.m. and closes at 11:00 a.m.
  - Any pieces that have not reached the fair market value by 11:00 a.m. on May 1, will be brought forward to the next bidding period.
  - ♦ All pieces that have reached or surpassed the fair market value, go to the highest bidder at 11:00 a.m. on May 1 and can be paid for and taken home at that time.
  - ♦ The second bidding period on May 1 starts at 11:00 a.m. and closes at 1:00 p.m.
  - ◊ All pieces go to the highest bidder and can be paid for and taken home at that time.
- You do not have to be present to receive your art piece. You will be notified via a phone call the day of the auction to make arrangements for payment and pick-up.

Art washes away from the soul the dust of everyday life.

Pablo Picasso

I Call Heaven and Earth, Deuteronomy 30: 19, is from the St. John's Bible. The artist is Suzanne Moore. Gilded wood frame, 14.5"x 26"

The art piece is a lithograph print. It is embossed with the St. John's Bible stamp. The word lithograph is derived from two ancient Greek words: lithos meaning stones, and graphien to write. meaning The practice is defined as a style of printing that makes use of the immiscibility of grease and water when they come into contact with another. While other printing methods require etching and other forms of imprints, lithography is unique because it more closely resembles painting.

The Saint John's Bible lithograph prints are generated from extremely high resolution image files, unlike the images you see on the internet. To ensure longevity, St. John's uses



pigment-based archival inks which are fade and rub resistant. The inks are guaranteed to last well over 100 years. The paper is Hahnemühle stock from Germany, which is considered one of the finest art papers in the world.

# Palm Sunday is a signed piece. The artist is unknown. It is a painting on papyrus; it has gilded accents. It is framed in a black wood frame.

The size is 20"x15".




