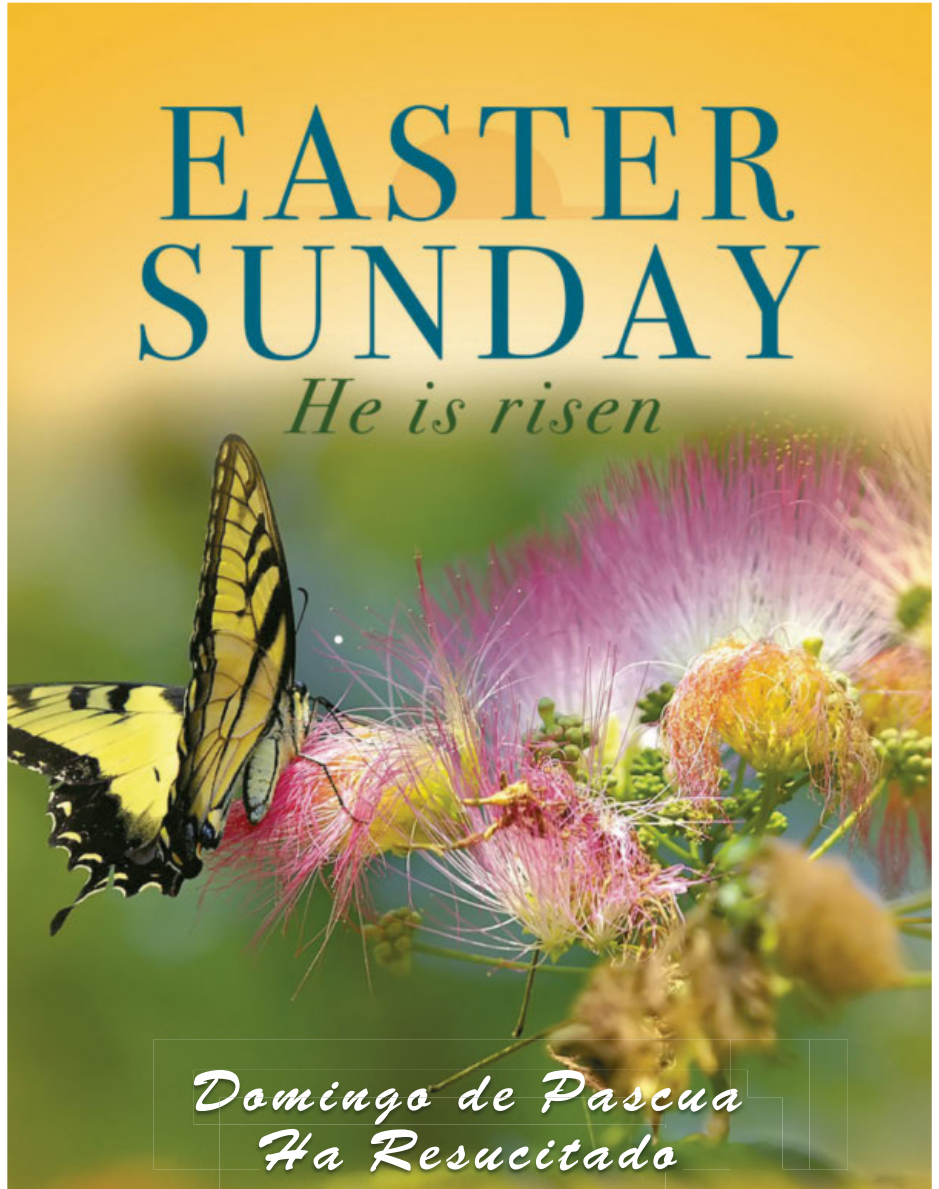

# Easter Sunday of the Resurrection of the Lord



There are many stones in our paths that keep us from truly living and being free. Some of these boulders have been there for a very long time. They have been there so long that they have even settled into the soil of our lives with other weeds, vines, and compacted soil keeping them firmly in place. We find them hard to move and trying to do so can be exhausting. What are these suffocating albatrosses that keep us so tethered and immobile? They are many things.

They are past childhood wounds and hurts that stem from disappointment, rejection, or abuse.

People may have told us we were unwanted, that the world is frightening, that there are only some acceptable feelings you can have and others you cannot. We may have tried to love someone or struggled to figure out how and were met with rejection. Maybe we trusted someone completely and were betrayed. We come to life collecting barnacles that begin to attach to other barnacles and before you know it, we have a mass of solid matter blocking our vision and keeping us from moving. We live in fear. We are afraid of losing what we have, afraid that the future will be empty, afraid that we won't succeed and even more afraid that we will not be loved. There is so much fear. Didn't Jesus tell us not to worry and to not be afraid? Either we believe in the message of Easter, or we don't!

Go confidently into the night. Walking with God you will find the light and strength you need. Often without even knowing, God will move those boulders and stumbling blocks that bind us and, with putting one foot in front of the other and looking forward, we will move. The resurrection of Christ is really all about receiving the gifts of trust and faith and doing new things. The rocks that bind us keep us spinning the same wheels and doing the same things. When was the last time you threw caution to the wind and actually did something totally out of character and different? This is where we find God, in the spontaneous, the adventurous, the fun, and the creative choices we make! God is not boring and stuck. God is exciting and engaging. Jesus Christ is risen from the dead! Find a way to trust that this is true and live.

Fr. Jim Gorman served as Associate Pastor at Risen Savior from 1995 until his retirement in 2011. After his retirement, he continued to help with Masses and celebrations at Risen Savior. He passed away in January 2017 after a lengthy battle with cancer.

Fr. Jim was an avid art collector and loved many different styles of art, from religious icons to florals and landscapes to abstracts. A couple of years after his death, Fr. Jim's family graciously donated a large part of his collection to Risen Savior. There are over 106 pieces.

## **"Must Know" Silent Auction Information**

### **Art categories:**

Icons, religious art, landscapes, florals, music, abstract, history/Egypt, contemporary, and odds and ends.

### **Silent Auction bidding process:**

Each piece of art has a bid sheet displaying the title of the piece, the fair market value, minimum bid increment, and starting bid.

- On Saturday, April 30, bidding closes at 7:45 p.m.
  - ◊ Any pieces that have not reached the fair market value by 7:45 p.m. on April 30, will be brought forward to the auction on Sunday, May 1.
  - ◊ All pieces that have reached or surpassed the fair market value, go to the highest bidder at 7:45 p.m. on April 30 and can be paid for and taken home that day.
- On Sunday, May 1, we are offering several bidding periods.
  - ◊ The first bidding period starts at 8:30 a.m. and closes at 11:00 a.m.
  - ◊ Any pieces that have not reached the fair market value by 11:00 a.m. on May 1, will be brought forward to the next bidding period.
  - ◊ All pieces that have reached or surpassed the fair market value, go to the highest bidder at 11:00 a.m. on May 1 and can be paid for and taken home at that time.
  - ◊ The second bidding period on May 1 starts at 11:00 a.m. and closes at 1:00 p.m.
  - ◊ All pieces go to the highest bidder and can be paid for and taken home at that time.
- You do not have to be present to receive your art piece. You will be notified via a phone call the day of the auction to make arrangements for payment and pick-up.
- Payments can be made in cash, by check (made out to Risen Savior) or by credit card.

### ***The Royal Musicians of Nakht***

Original painting on papyrus, signed (artist unknown)  
wood frame, gold-colored inlay, size is 10.5"x 13.5"

Music was a source of pleasure and entertainment for rich Egyptians concluding from the number of musical instruments discovered in tombs. The main instrument was the harp, followed by the flute. In this painting found in the tomb of Nakht (an astronomer of the God Amun during the reign of Amenhotep III) we see a harp player, a flute player, and a norva player (the latter one being close to a banjo made out of a turtle shell). Dressed in light clothes, the musicians have incense sticks and lotus flowers over their heads. This piece is hand painted art in the ancient technique, on genuine papyrus.

The death of Marc Chagall's wife, Bella, in 1944, plunged him into a grief so profound that he was unable to work for almost a year. But his love of life and art gradually reasserted themselves, and in 1952 he met and married Valentina Brodsky (called "Vava") in the Provence village of Saint Paul-de-Vence. A blue horse appears with the airborne lovers, who ascend from a brilliant red ground illuminated by a huge celestial bouquet.
