## April 24, 2022 2nd Sunday of Easter (Divine Mercy Sunday)



Even Thomas struggles to remove his boulder! Being very pragmatic and determined, he wants to see the risen Christ for himself! Thomas's boulder is heavy with mistrust. Many of ours are too. A certain amount of skepticism is good, as it can save us from being duped or misled. But we can become so skeptical of things that it erodes our ability to trust anything we see or hear. Skepticism can actually be a well-disguised defense mechanism that we use to prevent us from being hurt or perceived as a fool. Having too much ego protection is a real risk. Thomas, because of the boulder blocking his vision, could not even trust the word of his friends.

Boulders are hard to move. It's difficult to seek change or take a risk, especially when we are so afraid to be vulnerable or reluctant to trust another's word. When we are closed minded, overly pragmatic, unwilling to see things in a different way, stubborn or defensive, it is difficult to be surprised by God and stretched. We need to be less guarded, self-assured, and self-absorbed. God cannot break into the ordinary moments of our lives and

inspire us when we cling to doubt. If we are going to discover resurrection faith, we have to believe that what the witnesses say is true, especially when they are credible. We also have to trust that the risen Christ is alive in us, too!

While the first witnesses to the resurrection have faded into history, there are many others who have come after them. They continue to inspire by walking the talk of faith. They are the martyrs who offer their lives for the Gospel, the simple holy people in our communities who cling so steadfastly to their faith, those who have touched despair and found new hope and the ones who, even in spite of ridicule, still pursue their hunger and thirst for God. They are our friends, acquaintances, biblical heroes, and saints, and many others who are convinced that they have seen the Lord! The risen Christ may not surprise us with the same kind of visit as he did the first disciples, but God finds other ways. All we have to do is open our eyes, remove whatever is preventing us from seeing and believing and exclaim: "My Lord and my God!"

The agenda for the April 4, 2022 meeting of the *Building & Grounds Committee* contained tasks that did not warrant an in-person meeting. However, the tasks of getting bids, reaching out to vendors and reviewing our 10-year repair and replacement plan are moving ahead.

• Sweepers: There seems to be a need for a larger vacuum/sweeper (22-28"?). Facility

managers are being contacted for recommendations. Gerardo has checked with the *Dalco* sales rep and has information on *Terra 28B, Tennant* and *New Clark* sweepers.

- LED project: Should we be swapping lights to LEDs in the Youth Room and other locations? Getting bids does not hurt.
- In progress Risen Savior replacement and 10-year plan: This is the document that goes to Catholic Mutual to fulfill our PACE/PRISM requirements. A revised template was distributed. It was recommend that a financial planning line be added at the bottom of the spreadsheet which would show us the current balances of our Building & Grounds fund, along with projected incomes. It was recommended that cost escalation assumptions and investment growth assumptions in the revenue be included in the forecasts of the building fund and replacement costs. There is a need locate any old copy files of old facilities projects and include them in the template.
- Repair note: After nearly 30 years, the kitchen coffee brewer stopped functioning. A new brewer arrived this week.

  - All pieces that have reached or surpassed the fair market value, go to the highest bidder at 7:45 p.m. on April 30 and can be paid for and taken home that day.
- On Sunday, May 1, we are offering several bidding periods.
  - ♦ The first bidding period starts at 8:30 a.m. and closes at 11:00 a.m.
  - Any pieces that have not reached the fair market value by 11:00 a.m. on May 1, will be brought forward to the next bidding period.
  - All pieces that have reached or surpassed the fair market value, go to the highest bidder at 11:00 a.m. on May 1 and can be paid for and taken home at that time.

The theme is "For a Synodal Church: communion, participation, and mission." *Synodal* means journeying together as the *People of God*, following Jesus who is the way and listening the Holy Spirit together. It is an invitation to "authentic listening, dialogue, and discernment on the path of becoming the Church that God calls us to be" (Vademecum 1.2).

Our Archdiocesan *Synod* (which began in May 2019 and will culminate in June 2022) has its own focus on our local archdiocesan church; however, each of us are also welcome to participate in the global Synod on *Synodality* by June 30, 2022. There are several ways you can participate:

## Celebrate Earth Day this Weekend with the Environmental Concerns Committee

Earth Day was on April 22. Earth Day was first celebrated in 1970, conceived by Senator Gaylord Nelson of Wisconsin as a way to bring attention to issues related to the environment. As a result, the environmental movement became influential in creating NOAA and the EPA and passing environmental legislation like the Clean Air Act, Endangered Species Act and more. Risen Savior's Environmental Concerns Committee will participate in Earth Day this year in two ways. First, THIS weekend of April 23-24, after masses we will be handing out free tree saplings for parishioners to take home and plant in your yards. There will be three species of oak trees to choose from. Secondly, our ECC applied for and won a \$1000 grant from the Catholic Climate Covenant and Victory Noll Sisters, money which will be used to plant a native Minnesota tree on the Risen Savior grounds. The kind of tree and where it will be located are still to be determined. We will also have a ceremony to mark the planting of the tree. The information about that event will be related later, probably sometime in May. Stay tuned!



La Liturgia de este II Domingo de Pascua celebra el Domingo de la Misericordia. El Evangelio nos dice que ocho días después se les apareció Jesús. Bridándoles su paz entonces y ahora a nosotros. Esa paz que no se va, la que se queda en el corazón y se brinda a los hermanos y hermanas que están a nuestro alrededor. "¡La paz este con ustedes!" (Juan 20:21). Esas hermosas palabras de Jesús hacen eco en nuestro mundo, roto por el sufrimiento, en palabras del Papa Francisco en la actualidad.
