## Recognize God in Your Ordinary Moments

### *Gifts in Disguise*



Have you ever opened a gift and wondered what the giver was thinking?

I won't call out any of my family or friends here, but suffice to say, I think we have all been the confused recipient of a sweater that wasn't our size or a gift card to a store where we don't shop. But we smiled all the same and said how much it meant to us, because we know that when it comes to gifts, it's all about the gesture.

Suffering is a lot like that — the gift you never asked for, and don't really want to receive. Sometimes we look at suffering and, like the apostles who see Jesus as a stranger on the shore, we don't recognize it for what it can be. We don't appreciate the catalyst suffering can be for change, for growth, for grace.

What was the gift that you received in disguise? Was it a relationship that confounded and frustrated you? Was it a job that tested your spirit? An obstacle that stopped you dead in your tracks? A rejection that threatened to break your spirit?

If I go back and look at the worst gifts I've ever gotten, chances are that I didn't like them because I didn't know what to do with them — they were more fitted for someone else's interests, someone else's life. It's the same with suffering. We're tempted to cast suffering aside when it comes our way because it doesn't fit the person we are. Suffering is made to fit the person God knows we have the ability, with his grace, to become. Hang onto that suffering. Unlike the misshapen sweater, it really will come in handy.

It's time again for Faith Formation Registration at Risen Savior! This year, parishioners will NOT be able to register their children online since the current website is being rebuilt. We apologize for this inconvenience.

## Pope Francis' Synod on Synodality: What is it?



Did you know that in October Pope Francis called for a global *Church Synod Process* to start? Typically, the *Synod of Bishops* meets to dialogue and discern the Church's response to a particular issue. However, Pope Francis is asking ALL Catholics (practicing, lukewarm, or former members) to speak up and participate! The theme is "For a Synodal Church: communion,

participation, and mission." *Synodal* means journeying together as the *People of God*, following Jesus who is the way and listening the Holy Spirit together. It is an invitation to "authentic listening, dialogue, and discernment on the path of becoming the Church that God calls us to be" (Vademecum 1.2).

Our Archdiocesan *Synod* (which began in May 2019 and will culminate in June 2022) has its own focus on our local archdiocesan church; however, each of us are also welcome to participate in the global Synod on *Synodality* by June 30, 2022. There are several ways you can participate:

La alegría de la resurrección sigue en nuestras asambleas litúrgicas. Las oraciones y alabanzas, junto con la antifona de entrada, nos ayudan a reflexionar en ello: “Aclamen al Señor, habitantes todos de la tierra, canten un himno a su nombre, denle gracias y alábenlo. Aleluya”. Se apareció resucitado a sus discípulos en Galilea. Les preparó un suculento desayuno y les invitó diciendo: “Vengan a desayunar. Ninguno de los discípulos se atrevió a preguntarle quien era, pues sabían que era el Señor. Jesús se acercó, tomó el pan y se lo repartió. Lo mismo hizo con los pescados” (Juan 21:12-13).

“Esta fue la tercera vez que Jesús se apareció a sus discípulos después de resucitar de entre los muertos” (Juan 21:14). Tres veces les saluda brindándoles su paz, y les prepara el desayuno. Luego de desayunar, Jesús le pregunta a Pedro si lo ama. Tres veces fue la pregunta y Pedro responde tres veces la misma respuesta: “Sí, Señor, tú sabes que te quiero”. A lo que Jesús
