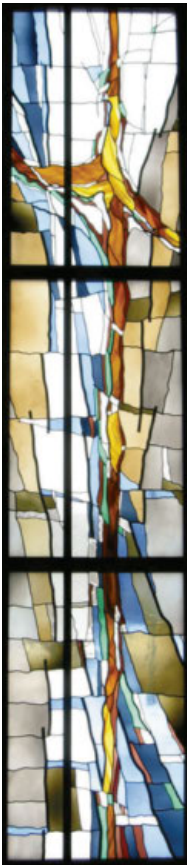

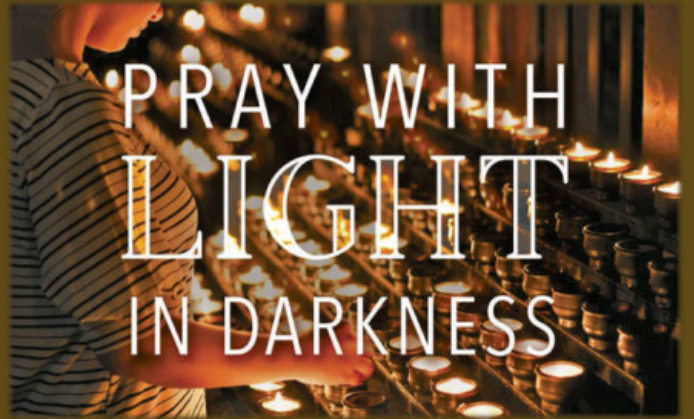
3RD SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

When I was a young seminarian, I asked a wise old priest how to pray better. He said simply, "Don't lie when you pray." He helped me to see how much energy I waste in trying to appear acceptable to God when I pray. For me, prayer was showing off for God and hiding what was ugly.

It's stunning that the Gospel of Matthew tells us of Jesus, "He left Nazareth and went to live in Capernaum by the sea, in the region of Zebulon and Naphtali..." This isn't just the Lord's relocation up north. It's his moving into places of shame and defeat. This region was where the enemy invasion of Israel began centuries before. Jesus left the comfortable confines of Nazareth and sought out a place of darkness, not to bring shame, but to announce the dawning of his light.

When we pray, we usually prefer Jesus to stay put in our little Nazareths — where we feel comfortable, successful, and in control. But he moves. He re-locates into the Zebulons and Naphtalis of our shame, embarrassment, fear, and sense of being defeated. The question for us is: will we allow him to take up residence in those places in our prayer time? Will we talk to him honestly about our places of darkness? If we do, we're no longer lying when we pray.

MARDI GRAS HOEDOWN

Beads and Bandanas Family Dance

Join us on Friday, February 17, from 7:00-10:00 p.m. for this fun, mid-winter *Mardi Gras Hoedown* Family Dance event. Rock and step it to the music of three different bands. Check out the general itinerary for the evening:

6:45 p.m.: Doors open

7:00 p.m.: Welcome

7:10 p.m.: *Jamtastics* (light country rock - *Take Me Home Country Roads, Wagon Wheel, Will the Circle Be Unbroken*, etc.), dance & instruction

8:00 p.m.: Break - refreshments, snacks, and King Cake.



Why is it called King Cake? The name is derived from the three wise men in the bible, who came bearing gifts for Baby Jesus on the Twelfth Night. King cake is first served on King's Day (January 6) and lasts through the eve of Mardi Gras to celebrate the coming of the three kings and to honor them with a sweet homage to their jeweled crowns.

What is a King Cake? It is a frosted seasonal cake that Mardi Gras goers eat between January 6, otherwise know as King's Day or Twelfth Night, and Fat Tuesday. The frosting is usually gold, green, and purple, the royal colors of Mardi Gras. Gold represents power, green is associated with faith (Ordinary Time), and purple illustrates justice. Buried inside the batter is a tiny, plastic baby figurine.

Why is there a baby figurine inside the King Cake? The plastic baby figurine is symbolic of Baby Jesus because of the religious connection to King's Day. The lucky individual who scores the piece of King Cake with the baby figurine inside is said to gain favor and, at our Risen Savior *Mardi Gras Hoedown* celebration, will be crowned "King" for the night with a "royal crown and robe." This lucky person will lead the Mardi Gras parade through the room to the tune of *When the Saints Go Marching In*.

8:45 p.m.: *FiddleStix* (traditional square dance tunes like *Cotton Eye Joe, Tennessee Walz*, and more), dance & instruction

9:30 p.m.: Sandy Jimenez' Latin Band (Latin tunes), dance & instruction (Cha Cha, Merengue, etc.)

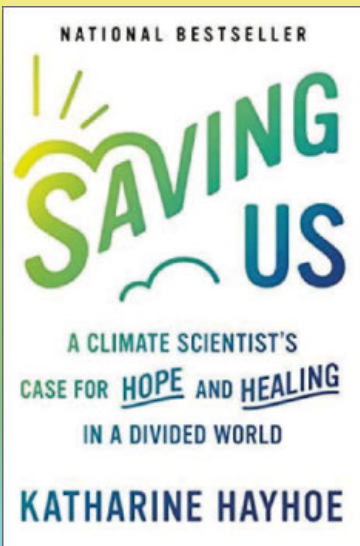

Did you know...

...that human traffickers are in it for the money, with estimated annual global profits of \$150 billion. \$99 billion of this comes from commercial sexual exploitation. Traffickers victimize an estimated 25 million people worldwide, with 80% in forced labor and 20% in sex trafficking. (Statistics from the U.S. Department of Homeland Security.)

...los traficantes de personas están en esto por el dinero, con ganancias globales anuales estimadas en \$150 mil millones. \$ 99 mil millones esto proviene de la explotación sexual comercial. Los traficantes victimizan a aproximadamente 25 millones de personas en todo el mundo, con un 80% en trabajos forzados y un 20% en tráfico sexual. (Estadísticas del Departamento de Seguridad Nacional de EE. UU.)
