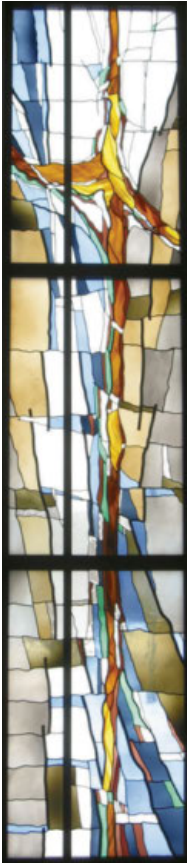

4th Sunday in Ordinary Time

In my parents' bedroom there were on the wall two photos of my mom and dad from their early adulthoods. The photo of my mother entranced me when I was a boy. I loved looking at it, even though I saw her in daily life. Something about that picture captured her perfectly. It was an image of the joy, wisdom, beauty, and strength that enveloped me from the start of my life. It was an icon of the woman who fed, taught, and encouraged me. I felt a deep pride that I came from such beauty.

The beatitudes of Jesus are a kind of self-portrait. But it is a strange picture. At first, the blessings of being poor, mourning, and hungering and thirsting for righteousness may seem bizarre or, worse, a religious delusion. Who wants to look like that? But if we look again, we begin to see the characteristics of Jesus' form. He becomes poor and fills it with his riches for us, he weeps and mourns for us, and fills it with his joy, he hungers and thirsts for us to be righteous, and so satisfies us. And so on. It's the way he appears on the cross.

Perhaps we should put on our bedroom room walls the words of the beatitudes next to a crucifix of the Lord Jesus. Then we can do what the beatitudes are designed for, to gaze at the joy, wisdom, beauty, and strength of the one who is our origin, and who is with us every day. And little by little, we'll start to look like him.



MARDI GRAS HOEDOWN

Beads and Bandanas Family Dance

Join us on Friday, February 17, from 7:00-10:00 p.m. for this fun, mid-winter *Mardi Gras Hoedown* Family Dance event. Rock and step it to the music of three different bands. Check out the general itinerary for the evening:

6:45 p.m.: Doors open

7:00 p.m.: Welcome

7:10 p.m.: *Jamtastics* - 5 musicians: female vocal with guitar, male vocal with guitar, male vocal with bass guitar, male vocal with harmonica, male vocal with banjo. Style is light country rock - *Take Me Home Country Roads, Wagon Wheel, Will the Circle Be Unbroken*, etc. Dance & instruction

8:00 p.m.: Break - refreshments, snacks, and King Cake.

Why is it called King Cake? The name is derived from the three wise men in the bible, who came bearing gifts for Baby Jesus on the Twelfth Night. King cake is first served on King's Day (January 6) and lasts through the eve of Mardi Gras to celebrate the coming of the three kings and to honor them with a sweet homage to their jeweled crowns.

What is a King Cake? It is a frosted seasonal cake that Mardi Gras goers eat between January 6, otherwise know as King's Day or Twelfth Night, and Fat Tuesday. The frosting is usually gold, green, and purple, the royal colors of Mardi Gras. Gold represents power, green is associated with faith (Ordinary Time), and purple illustrates justice. Buried inside the batter is a tiny, plastic baby figurine.

Why is there a baby figurine inside the King Cake? The plastic baby figurine is symbolic of Baby Jesus because of the religious connection to King's Day. The lucky individual who scores the piece of King Cake with the baby figurine inside is said to gain favor and, at our Risen Savior *Mardi Gras Hoedown* celebration, will be crowned "King" for the night with a "royal crown and robe." This lucky person will lead the Mardi Gras parade through the room to the tune of *When the Saints Go Marching In*.

8:45 p.m.: *FiddleStix* - 5 musicians: 2 fiddles, bass guitar, guitar, banjo. Music style is traditional square dance. They will be performing tunes like *Cotton Eye Joe, Tennessee Walz*, and more. Dance & instruction.

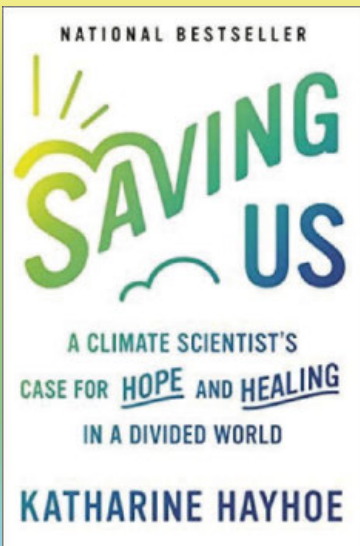
9:30 p.m.: Sandy Jimenez' Latin Band (Latin tunes), dance & instruction (Cha Cha, Merengue, etc.)

January 11 -February 8: A Month of Prayers to End Human Trafficking

January 11 is National Human Trafficking Awareness Day. February 8 is the Feast of St. Josephine Bakhita, patron saint of victims of human trafficking. Throughout this month, Risen Savior's Human Trafficking Committee invites you to use the bulletin insert to pray daily for an end to human trafficking. How are victims trafficked?

Human traffickers prey on an individual's vulnerabilities. The top five factors that may place a victim at risk are:

1. Recent migration or relocation
2. Substance use
3. Runaway and/or homeless youth
4. Mental health concern
5. Involvement in the child welfare system.

Most likely, these victims are coerced through isolation and emotional, economic, and/or physical abuse.

¿Cómo son traficadas las víctimas?

Los traficantes de personas se aprovechan de la vulnerabilidad de un individuo. Los cinco factores principales que pueden poner en riesgo a una víctima son:

1. Migración o reubicación reciente
2. Consumo de sustancias
3. Jóvenes fugitivos y/o sin hogar
4. Preocupación por la salud mental
5. Participación en el sistema de bienestar infantil.
