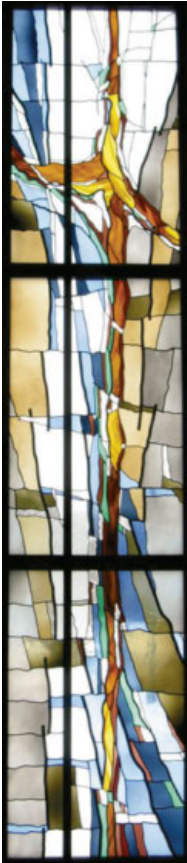

Easter Flowers

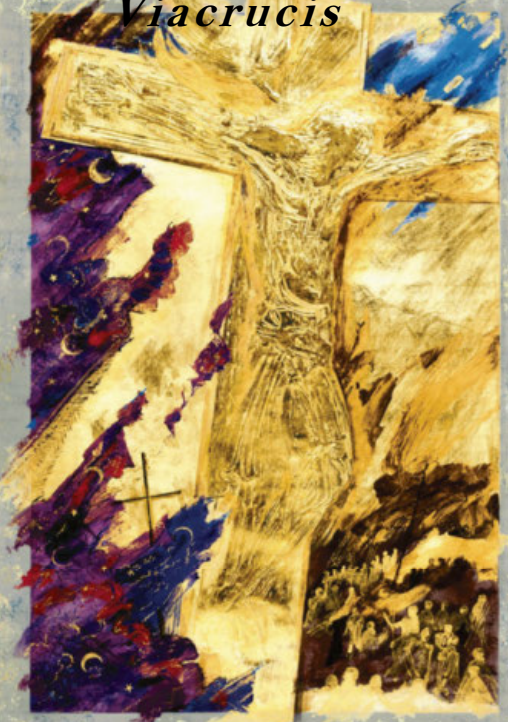

RCIA News

RCIA is the process through which adults enter into the Catholic Church through sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist. This year, we have 3 adults in the English RCIA group and 7 adults in the Spanish RICA group. All of our candidates have already been baptized and are seeking either or both Eucharist and Confirmation.

On February 26 we celebrated 2 special rites: the *Rite of Sending* at Risen Savior and the *Rite of Election & Call to Continuing Conversion* at the Cathedral of St. Paul. These rites mark the transition for candidates from their intense period of learning (catechumenate) into the Lenten period of formation focused on deepened prayer (purification and enlightenment). At this point, the candidates have responded "YES!" to God's invitation to relationship with God through the Catholic community.

I am pleased to introduce the *Parish Synod Evangelization* team members *Mary Anttila, Maria Castellon, Rebecca Dobias, Michele Enstrom, Israel & Melissa Higuera, Dave Hutton, Theresa Lummis, Fr. Matthew Malek, Ken Mosier, Nalleli Renteria, and Fr. Tim Rudolphi.*

In the coming weeks, you will hear from each of the *Evangelization* team members who will be sharing who they are and how they respond to God's call to be part of the team.

The role of the *Synod Evangelization* team is to help carry out the three-year vision laid out in the archbishop's pastoral letter "You will be my Witnesses," which I encourage you to read. The first-year goal beginning July 2023-June 2024 is for each parish to build a series of small groups that reach the marginalized and the poor. Some examples might include, but not limited to:

- Small faith sharing groups at nursing homes.
- Small groups whose members have an apostolate with the poor.
- Small groups that provide corporal and spiritual works of mercy for those in need.
- Small groups whose members focus on Catholic Social Teachings and putting them into practice.
