

Divine fire is like a good coach: it demands the removal of all that obstructs the achievement of the lofty goal.

How is your life demanding right now? That inconvenient family situation, the unfair boss at work, the kids who reject their parents' wishes, the nagging health issue? Maybe things would be more peaceful devoid of these seemingly arbitrary difficulties. But for us who believe in the one who comes to set the earth of fire, we should be much more worried if he stops demanding so much from us. In fact, let's thank him for it. He sees how glorious we can become.

## OCIA: An Invitation to Learn More About How to Become a Catholic

The *Order of Christian Initiation of Adults* (OCIA), formerly known as RCIA, is a process within the Catholic Church for adults to become Catholic and receive the sacraments of initiation (Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist). It involves a journey of spiritual formation, catechesis, and integration into the Catholic community.

Are you someone or do you know someone who . . .

- Has expressed an interest in becoming Catholic?
- Has a child over the age of seven who has not been baptized?
- Was baptized Catholic as a child, but has not celebrated the Sacraments of Confirmation and Eucharist?

The OCIA process is designed for adults who are unbaptized, baptized in another Christian tradition, or baptized Catholics who have not received all of the Sacraments of Initiation (Confirmation and Eucharist). It is a journey of faith that involves prayer, study, reflection, and sharing. Participants are encouraged to ask questions, share their insights, and tell their faith stories.

The sessions focus on various aspects of the Catholic faith, including Scripture, Church history, the Sacraments, morality, and prayer. The goal is to provide participants with a comprehensive understanding of the Catholic faith and to help them develop a personal relationship with Jesus Christ.

The OCIA process culminates with the celebration of the Sacraments of Initiation during the Easter season. This is a joyous occasion for the entire parish community as we welcome new members into the Church.

You are invited to participate in the OCIA process with your questions, your insights, and your faith story. We believe that everyone has something to contribute to the group.

# KIDS WILL LOVE THIS YEAR'S FALL FEST



The time frame for all games is 2:30-4:30 p.m.

\*Each game requires tickets. Tickets are \$.25/each and can be purchased on the day of the Fall Fest at the black desk in the commons and in Resurrection Hall at the ticket station at the bottom of the stairs. No advance ticket sale. Tickets are valid on September 21 only. You may redeem unused tickets for cash back on September 21 only until 5:30 p.m.; this can be done at the ticket stations.

Two trained volunteers will run and supervise the children's games. Children will receive child-size canvas totes to collect their prizes. Check this out:

- *Ring Toss* (1 ticket\*); 1 game = 3 throws, (best of 3). Toss a glow ring onto a juice bottle and win the drink. (Dorothy Day Room)
- *Corn Hole Toss #1* (1 ticket\*); 1 game = 3 throws, (best of 3). Toss a bean bag into the hole on the corn hole board and win a mini toy bear. (Library)


