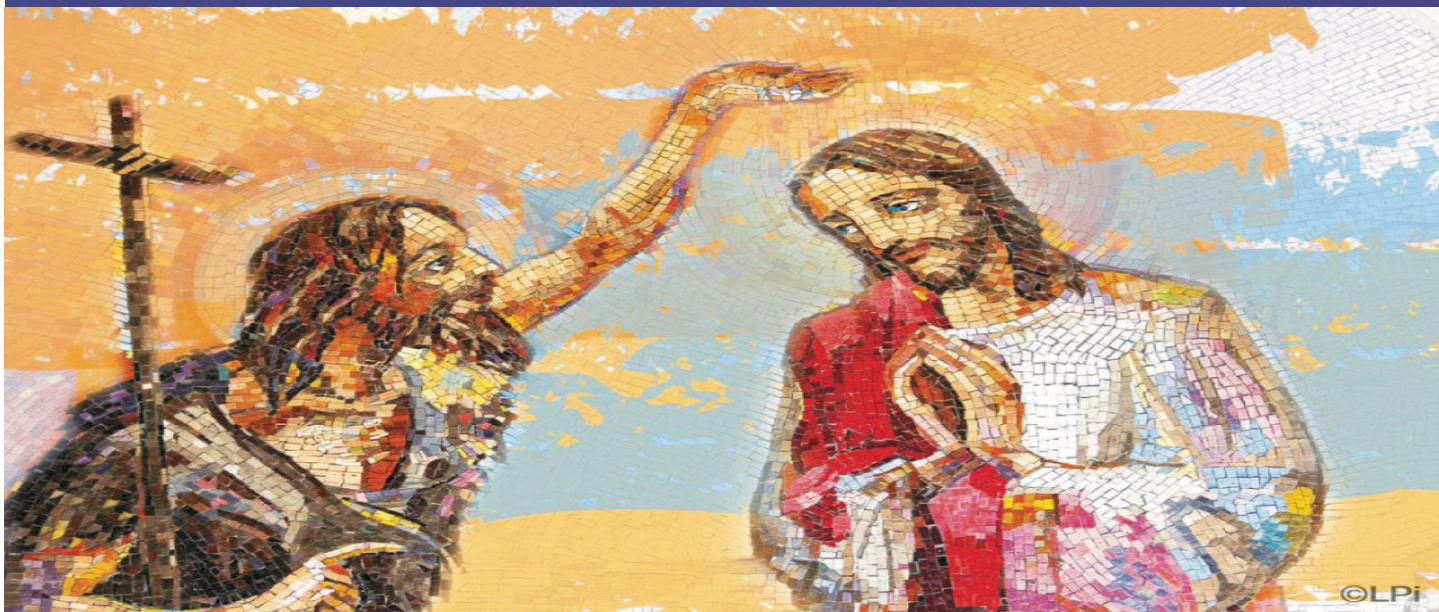

#### **Message from Father Cory Rohlfing**

“In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was in the beginning with God. All things came to be through him, and without him nothing came to be.” (JN 1:1)  
 How beautiful that Mother Church provides these first words of John’s Gospel, so timeless and deep, to help us reflect on the awesome nature of God as we close out another calendar year. In the beginning—before any of our days were numbered, before human beings existed, before God separated light from darkness (Genesis 1: 3-4)—Our Lord is. In our world, time passes, we grow old, and everything is in flux, so we draw consolation from the truth that God never changes. He loved us just as much before the world was created as he does today, and will for all eternity. How blessed we are, mere creatures, to be so beloved by the Creator of all!

Lest we settle for being mere creatures, John reminds us that we have “been given the power to become children of God.” We are required only to accept him, to believe in his name, and to be born “not by natural generation nor by human choice nor by a man’s decision but of God.” Our divine filiation merits us unique spiritual gifts and graces from the moment of our baptism to our final breath. For our part, we honor our God with love and obedience, desiring with our whole heart this most intimate relationship. Our inheritance as children of God is nothing less than Heaven, tastes of which we can savor right here and now.

John the Baptist was called by Jesus the greatest man born of a woman (Matthew 11:11), as the bridge between the Old and New Testaments, the person entrusted with preparing the way for the coming of the Messiah, and the prophet who was honored to proclaim Jesus “Lamb of God” at his baptism. John’s mission was lofty, of eternal significance. To be appointed by God to such a position in salvation history would be daunting. Yet, in the economy of salvation, each of us has an important and unrepeatable role to play. We probably don’t dress in hair shirts or eat locusts, but we are nevertheless called to witness to our faith in uncomfortable ways. As this year begins, let’s reflect on the witness we have given and look ahead, begging God to make his will known in the new year.

## Music Ministry

To the Faith Community of Divine Mercy,

I have been overwhelmed with such a warm welcome from you. It is indeed "good for me to be here". I am especially pleased with how our "Christmas Choir" quickly formed and brought us beauty over the Advent and Christmas Season. Choir members all agree it is good to be singing again, so we will continue this important music ministry as The *Parish Choir of Divine Mercy*. Rehearsals will resume on Wednesday, January 12th from 6:30 to 8:00 pm in the church. All are welcome to join the choir. No auditions are held but good sightreading and some experience in choral singing is appreciated.

Our Green Gather Hymnals have seen better days and unfortunately all its Mass settings are now obsolete. When discussing this reality with Fr. Cory and Philip Parrish, I discouraged the idea of purchasing new pew Hymnals, not only for the expense involved but because the Church now sings such a wide variety of musical styles that one single edition will not contain it all.

To this end, I have produced *A Music Supplement* for the pews. This contains notated music from numerous sources; three Mass settings, Psalms, Hymns and Songs. This music will be familiar to many of you and some will be new, but accessible and good for liturgical prayer.

I would like for you to consider the Seven Sundays of our Winter Ordinary Time, beginning on January 16th and prayerfully consider your participation in the choir, as cantor, or as Psalmist. Since not everyone has the availability for rehearsals, please consider your participation in the singing assembly. Even if you "can't sing", take the Hymnal or Supplement, and follow along with the texts.

The Parish Choir of Divine Mercy will resume weekend singing in Lent, beginning on March 2nd: *Ash Wednesday*. Please remember also that we have a beautiful 3 octave set of handbells. 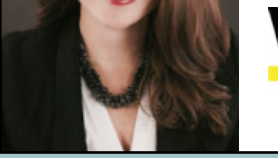
