





The finance report for the fiscal year July 2024-June 2025 will look a little different than in the past. We are moving toward a more comprehensive picture for everyone. In the past, only the adult weekly envelopes were reported, which did not give a full picture of the financial well-being of the parishes. This year the full income will be reported in the bulletin. Everything that was taken in during the week will be put into the bulletin. There will be no names printed in the bulletin associated with anything that has been given, so if any anonymous donations are made for something, you can still be anonymous. Also, in the past, the weekly budget was based on adult weekly envelopes. This too will change. The total Revenue Goal will be used as the budget amount. These new reports will appear monthly and will remain in the bulletin until next month's report is available. This will be done to hopefully even out any spikes in donations throughout the month and give a more accurate picture.
