Overview of Catholic Education: Part I

Catholic education is rooted in the 2,500 year-old classical education tradition that began with the Greek philosophers and was developed extensively by the Christian monastery and cathedral schools throughout the medieval millennium.

Immediate goal of this tradition is the cultivation of moral and intellectual virtues. Many Catholics know the four Cardinal Virtues: Temperance, Prudence, Justice, and Fortitude. The person whose education bestows virtuous character to the mind as well as to the will is "liberated" from enslavement to his own desires and appetites on one hand. He is also "liberated" from the risk of losing his personal faith, hope, or charity in the midst of the inevitable challenges life will send to him. He has been prepared for a life of true freedom, and this is why we call the traditional educational curriculum a "liberal education."
