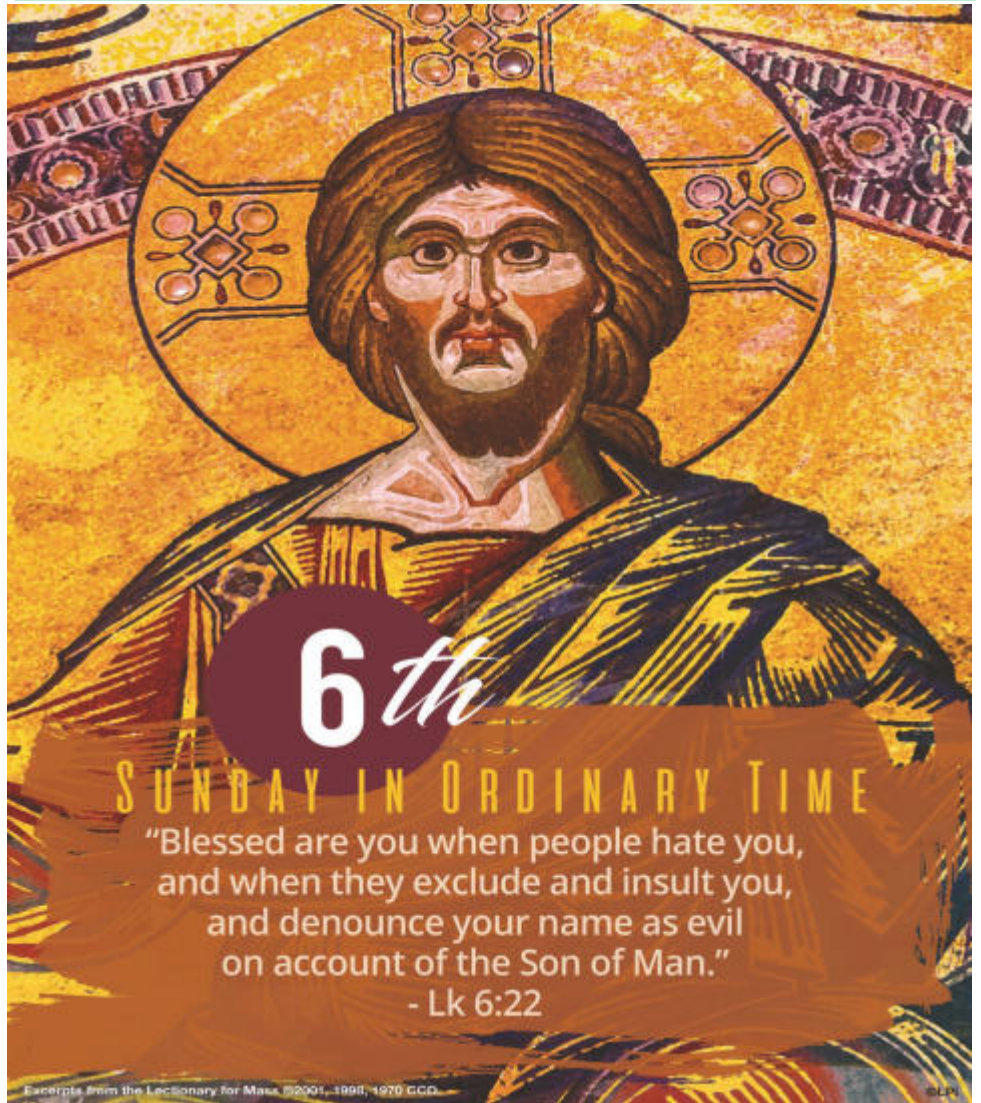

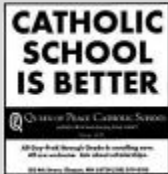

“Blessed are you when people hate you...exclude and insult you, and denounce your name...on account of the Son of Man”

Luke 6:22

All of us have been in situations when someone has made a negative comment or joke about God or our Catholic faith. How did you respond? Did you stay silent or pretend to go along with the crowd because you didn't want to cause waves and then, later, you felt bad? Know that God is with you all the time, the Holy Spirit will put the right words in your mouth. Pray for the strength and courage to proclaim our faith to others, especially during uncomfortable situations.



**Catholic Education Overview: Part II**

In Part I, we saw the basic idea behind what we call Liberal Education: it is designed to convey virtues that a free person needs to live nobly before God and men. This week we look at seven skill sets, called “arts,” that became recognized as essential for a free life in society. The seven classical “liberal arts” were first articulated by Benedictine monks, like Alcuin of York, who were gathered at Charlemagne’s court in the 9<sup>th</sup> century. The structure of our primary, secondary, and university systems today still reflect them. Becoming a “Bachelor” or even a “Master” of the arts (i.e., the B.A. and M.A. degrees) remains a nominal goal for many today.

The first three liberal arts are called the *Tri*-vium. They are Grammar, Logic, and Rhetoric. The trivium teaches a student how to think coherently on any subject. The next four liberal arts are called the *Quadri*-vium, and are actually four forms of math: Arithmetic, Music, Geometry, and Astronomy.

The trivium’s structured method of thought led monks like Albertus Magnus and Roger Bacon to versions of the scientific method by the 13<sup>th</sup> century, which in turn led to eventual scientific revolutions within the Christian world. Science comes from *Scientia*, which means “to know” in Latin. As disciplined thinkers uncovered increasing fields for exploration, we began to expand the original quadrivium and speak of the arts alongside newly discovered “sciences.”
